## CITY OF BURNABY

## BYLAW NO. 9850

## A BYLAW respecting outdoor food services and mobile retail carts

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 5, 1993.
- 2. Subsection (1) of section 301.2 of Schedule Number III of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(1) Every business or undertaking shall be conducted within a completely enclosed building except for
    - (a) parking and loading facilities,
    - (b) gasoline service stations,
    - (c) outdoor produce shops,
    - (d) outdoor garden shops, and
    - (e) outdoor seating at cafes, restaurants or other facilities where food or drink is served."
- 3. Subsection (1) of section 302.2 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(1) Every business or undertaking shall be conducted within a completely enclosed building except for
    - (a) parking and loading facilities,
    - (b) gasoline service stations,
    - (c) outdoor produce shops,
    - (d) outdoor garden shops, and

- (e) outdoor seating at cafes, restaurants or other facilities where food or drink is served."
  Section 303.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw
- 4. Section 303.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, after Item (26), the following:
  - "(27) Mobile retail carts, including but not limited to, mobile food carts, in finished, pedestrian-oriented open spaces where the use is included as part of a comprehensive development project subject to the provisions of the CD (Comprehensive Development)

    District provided that no cart exceeds a ground coverage of 2 m<sup>2</sup> (21.5 square feet) and no more than four carts are allocated to one open space area."
- 5. Subsection (1) of section 303.2 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(1) Every business or undertaking shall be conducted within a completely enclosed building except for
    - (a) parking and loading facilities,
    - (b) gasoline service stations,
    - (c) outdoor produce shops,
    - (d) outdoor garden shops,
    - (e) outdoor seating at cafes, restaurants or other facilities where food or drink is served, and
    - (f) mobile retail carts, including but not limited to, mobile food carts."
- 6. Subsection (1) of section 304.2 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(1) All business, repair or servicing uses shall be conducted within a completely enclosed building except for

- (a) permitted outdoor display,
- (b) rental, sales or storage yards,
- (c) parking and loading facilities,
- (d) gasoline service stations, and
- (e) outdoor seating at cafes, restaurants or other facilities where food or drink is served."
