

CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9861

A BYLAW to amend the fees charged under the  
Electrical Bylaw

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ELECTRICAL BYLAW 1974, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1993.
2. Appendix "A" of Burnaby Electrical Bylaw 1974 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"APPENDIX 'A'

ELECTRICAL PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES

	<u>FEE</u>
1. (1) Permit for One or Two-Family Dwelling: (Electrical system for a dwelling including service connection, telephone and Temporary Current Permit)	15% of Building Permit Fee (Minimum \$25.00)
(2) Additional charges:	
(a) Each hot tub or spa	\$18.00
(b) Each hydro massage bath tub	\$12.00
(c) Security system	Fee based on value of electrical installation
(d) Electric heating	Fee based on value of electrical installation

FEE

2. PERMIT FOR ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS OTHER THAN ONE AND TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS:  
(Fee based on value of electrical installation including materials and labour.)

Value of Electrical Installation  
(as approved by Electrical Inspector)

\$100 or less	\$25.00
\$101 - \$250	34.00
\$251 - \$500	50.00
\$501 - \$700	67.00
\$701 - \$1,000	87.00
\$1001 - \$10,000	\$87.00 plus \$37.00/\$1,000 or part thereof over \$1,000
\$10,001 - \$50,000	\$420.00 plus \$20.00/\$1,000 or part thereof over \$10,000
\$50,001 - \$100,000	\$1,220.00 plus \$12.00/\$1,000 or part thereof over \$50,000
\$100,001 - \$500,000	\$1,820.00 plus \$8.00/\$1,000 or part thereof over \$100,000
\$500,001 - \$1,500,000	\$5,020.00 plus \$7.00/\$1,000 or part thereof over \$500,000
\$1,500,001 and over	\$12,020.00 plus \$2.25/\$1,000 or part thereof over \$1,500,000

3. TEMPORARY CURRENT PERMIT: \$120.00  
(Not required for one or two-family dwelling)

4. ANNUAL PERMIT for one commercial or industrial plant or establishment  
(Based on service capacity) \$0.20/KVA  
Minimum \$120.00  
Maximum \$2,200.00

FEE

5. REINSPECTION FEE:

Where it has been determined by the Electrical Inspector that due to non-compliance with the provisions of this Bylaw, unsatisfactory workmanship or incomplete work, more than two inspections are necessary, the fee for each inspection after the second inspection shall be

\$60.00

6. SPECIAL INSPECTIONS:

(a) For an inspection requested by the owner but not required by the Bylaw

\$60.00/hour  
(\$60.00 minimum)

(b) For an inspection outside the hours during which the offices of the City Hall are normally open

\$400.00 plus \$90.00/  
hour or part thereof  
after the first four  
hours. Travel time  
included

(c) For an inspection that requires special arrangements because of length of time, frequency of inspection visits, location outside the City limits, construction techniques or otherwise

\$60.00 per hour  
(\$60.00 minimum)

7. PROVISIONAL OCCUPANCY FEE:

For an inspection for a Provisional Occupancy Permit when requested by the Owner, fees shall be charged under Item 6, Special Inspections.

8. PERMIT TRANSFER OR ASSIGNMENT FEE:

For the transfer or assignment of an electrical permit and to record a change of contractor for a project

\$25.00

9. PERMIT FEE REFUND:

Where no work has been performed under the permit, the fee less 10% may be returned when a request in writing is made for refund otherwise a fee is not refundable."


3. This Bylaw shall come into force on the first day of March, 1993.
