BYLAW NO. 9982

A BYLAW respecting restoration public houses

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 56, 1993.

2. Section 302.1 of Schedule Number III of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is amended by adding thereto the following:

"(16) Restoration public houses, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) compliance with the Liquor Control and Licensing Act and regulations pursuant thereto governing a Class I Licence; and
- (b) the use must be included as part of a comprehensive development plan subject to the CD (Comprehensive Development) District."

3. Section 303.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto the following:

"(28) Restoration public houses, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) compliance with the Liquor Control and Licensing Act and regulations pursuant thereto governing a Class I Licence; and



- (b) the use must be included as part of a comprehensive development plan subject to the CD (Comprehensive Development) District."
