CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9982

A BYLAW respecting restoration public houses

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 56, 1993.
- 2. Section 302.1 of Schedule Number III of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is amended by adding thereto the following:
 - "(16) Restoration public houses, subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) compliance with the <u>Liquor Control and Licensing Act</u> and regulations pursuant thereto governing a Class I Licence; and
 - (b) the use must be included as part of a comprehensive development plan subject to the CD (Comprehensive Development) District."
- 3. Section 303.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto the following:
 - "(28) Restoration public houses, subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) compliance with the <u>Liquor Control and Licensing Act</u> and regulations pursuant thereto governing a Class I Licence; and

(b) the use must be included as part of a comprehensive development plan subject to the CD (Comprehensive Development) District."
