It was moved and seconded by Councillors Sprott & Cliff that Burnaby Revenue By Law be read a third time carried By Law read a third time

Medical Health Officer's Report Re Lapoint's Slaughter house was then read received & filed - After the following action was taken - Moved & sec Cradland & Sprott that the clerk communicate with Mr Lapoint informing him of the recommendations of the M.H.O. and that said recommendation must be complied with on or before the 19 inst or an action at law will be taken to compel compliance carried

The Clerk was instructed to inform M.H.O. what action had been taken.

On motion of Councillors Stride & Cradland the clerk was instructed to request the Iron Co to replace planks taken from the Vancouver road

Councillor Austin intervened the Council in the matter of a bridge on the North road and proposed that some repairs be made which would make the bridge safe which would cost about \$23: The Council consented on condition that Coquitlam Council have the repairs done and Burnaby would adjust accounts with them after the work was completed Councillor Austin of Coquitlam reported
