The Council met in the Clerk's house  
356. 12<sup>th</sup> st. New Westminster.

Present Reeve Schne in the chair and  
Councillors Byrne, Stride, Cliff, Carter  
Smith & Sprott.

The Minutes of last meeting, 4<sup>th</sup> inst.,  
were read and adopted.

The Reeve reported that he had written  
to Mr. Thos. Kidd M.P.P. and the Hon. F. L. Q.  
Letter as to having an amt. for the improvement  
of the Trunk roads, included in the Estimate,  
but had rec'd no official reply.

The tenders, rec'd. for building a municipal  
hall in Burnaby were then opened and it  
was moved by Counc. Sprott seconded  
by Counc. Cliff and resolved, that the  
Tender of J. A. Allen to build the hall  
for \$906 be accepted & he be requested to  
furnish security, himself and another for  
\$250.

It was moved by Counc. Sprott seconded  
by Counc. Byrne & resolved that Mr. Bailey

be paid 2½ per cent commission for preparing plans being \$22.65.

It was moved by Coone. Ryne seconded by Coone. Sprott and resolved that Couns. Stride and Carter Smith be a special committee to look after the building of the Municipal Hall and purchase a door for the vault.

It was moved by Coone. Sprott seconded by Coone. Stride & resolved that Councillors Ryne and Cliff be a Committee to let a contract for putting McKay road, on Wednesday at 9 o'clock at McKay & Transway crossing.

It was moved by Coone. Ryne seconded by Coone. Sprott & resolved that a sub-committee consisting of Councillors Cliff and Smith meet Mr. Eastman at the Clerks office, on a day to be fixed by them, to take such action as they deem necessary to have the books written up for the auditor before next meeting of the Council.

On motion Messrs. Morris and D'ockrill were re-appointed as solicitors of this corporation for the current year on the same terms as the past year.

It was moved by Councillor Cliff & Sprott & resolved that tenders be called for the hauling onto the W & V<sup>rs</sup> of about 70 yds of cracked rock. Tenders to be called by Coone. Stride.
