The Council met time and place as above, all the members being present the Reeve presiding.

The minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

Councillor Smith reported re Gunn road bridge and his report was adopted and the work authorized to be done.

A cheque was ordered to be signed in favour of McLean & Simpson, ^{for \$100⁺} on acc. of their contract on the North road, no application having been received in time for last meeting of Council.

Also of the Coquitlam Council, value $41 \frac{66}{x}$, [#] mostly of its disbursements on acc. of North road. The Clerk reported he had received \$100⁺ on acc from the Coquitlam Council re North road.

Also ten cancelled paid Debenture Int. Coupons from the Bank, due Nov 1st for \$300⁺ in all.

Letters of thanks for copies of the By Law Book were received from Messrs Langley & Martin, the Dep. Provincial Secretary and the Provincial Librarian.

The tender of R. W. Hawthorn for work on North road was referred to the Inter-Committee.

Tenders were opened for laying work on Vancouver rd. as follows:-

John Wolfe .50 per yard.

Wesley Hatt-Cook .44 per yd.

On motion the contract was let to Mr Hatt-Cook.

Councillor Stude was empowered to act re. Mr Wilson's gravel at Central Park; also to expend \$50⁺ on broken work etc. at Central Park.

Councillor Spratt was also empowered to expend \$50⁺ on broken work for the repair of Hastings road.

The Clerk was instructed to inform Mr Geo R Love that unless sufficient extra labour be employed by the middle of the week, to ensure the completion of the work on North road, ~~by the~~ within 20 days, the contract would be cancelled.

The Council then adjourned to Saturday the 29th inst. when the November accounts would be taken up.
