

Municipal Hall, Bamaley.

16 August 1902, 2:30 pm.

A meeting of the Council was held here and place as above, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting were read & confirmed.

Mr Thomas Kidd M.P. wrote endorsing a copy of the Chief Commr's letter respecting the non grant of an appropriation for roads into the small holdings.

The Coroner wrote reporting the inquest on the body of the late Mrs Mary Mewzie, killed by the fall of a tree.

By laws.

The "Bamaley Electors By Law 1902" and the "Bamaley Trappi By Law 1902" were taken up, reconsidered, adopted and signed and sealed and ordered to be published according to law. The Clerk was also authorized to

have all the general standing by laws printed, and to certify a copy for reproduction at the County Court.

Bramette down

The Reeve reported that at a public meeting, held pursuant to advertisement at the Municipal Hall Street 6th, a resolution injurious to the proposed alteration of the level of Bamaley Lodge was passed.

North end

The Clerk was instructed to write to the Chief Commr of Lands & Works, enquiring as to a rumored appropriation of \$1000 for the Pat. Murdy road — and also to Messrs Stewart & Hawthorn urging the immediate completion of their contract on the same road.

Tenders were ordered to be advertised for a culvert and pier to replace a bridge on the Bamaley road at Central Park, and also for bushing the same road and cleaning the ditches from Central Park to Merson road, to be delivered before Sept 30.

Commissar Slide was empowered to have wire road west of Vaux road bushed out, and also certain repairs near Mrs Spelman's property on the Boulevard.

The meeting then adjourned to Sept 30 at 2:30 pm.
