

## Burnaby Hall

18<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1902, 2.30 pm.

The Council met time and place as above, all the members being present - the Reeve presiding.

The minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

Councillor Smith reported that the Inter-Committee (St. Vancouver) had met and authorized Comrade, Steele to expend \$50 in the repair of the bridge on Boundary Road at Central Park. Also that Kinnels contract work had been inspected and approved. Adopted.

The Council arranged to meet in committee at Mr. Love's at 10 a.m. Oct-31<sup>st</sup>. to inspect Cambria road, Gunn road and North road, & the Reeve was instructed to inform the Reeve of Coquitlam that the Reeve & Council would be glad to meet him at 1 p.m. at the junction of the two latter roads.

Councillors Bly, Smith & Byrne were appointed a Committee to draw up Specifications for the Bridge on Gunn road and to obtain tenders for the same.

18th October 1902

Councillor Strick was empowered to secure the repair of Vancouver road near the Skulpter Lane.

The Clerk was authorized to correct the location of lot 149. (re blues).

The Council then adjourned to Saturday November 1st at 2.30 pm.
