A meeting of the Council was held time and place as above and the members including Mr Reave being present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read & confirmed.

Councillor Smith reported as to the new road from North road East, between Lots 2 & 4 to lot 10, which he suggested should be called Gunn road; and it was

resolved that tenders be advertised for in the Colonbian for slashing 24 ft wide and logging 20 ft wide, a distance of 45 chains. The Clerk was instructed to secure the right of way.

Barnet road

Councillor Smith also reported as to Barnet road, and he was empowered to keep the road in repair until the Government completed it as a trunk road.

Roads in Lot 99.

Tenders were opened for the construction of roads in Lot 99 viz.

The contract was let to Mr Russell for both roads for \$125<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub>.

Boundary road.

A letter was read from the St. Vrain Inter-Committee proposing that new tenders should be called on the original specifications for Boundary road, and it was resolved to advertise in the Province to that effect.

McKay rd.

A complaint was received from Mr Jones re. bad place in McKay road, and Councillor Byrne was authorized to act.

R. Oak rd.

Councillor Steele was empowered to have the necessary slashing done on Royal Oak road.

Assessments.

Councillor Spratt was requested to report as to the existing improvements on the South half of Lot 118; and the Clerk was instructed to adjust the error in Mahon's rates Lot 80, S 1/2. It was resolved that \$386 be refunded to Geo D. Murray, overcharge for Lot 6 in Lot 99, and a cheque for \$75 be drawn in payment of the grant to the St. Vrain & Danbury National & Cycling Association.

Mr Willards communication re. Ditch was added to the file. A vote of thanks was passed for the complimentary tickets from the New West. Agric. & Indus. Socy, & the Council adjourned to Saturday Oct-4 at 2.30 pm.
