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A letter was read from Mr R L Green, endorsing a resolution passed at a meeting of ratepayers held at the West Barnaby School, Central Park, as follows:—

"That the Reeve and Councillors be requested to have all the municipality books (since the creation of the municipality) thoroughly checked & audited by some competent and well known firm of Auditors, on account of the number of complaints laid before this meeting, of mistakes & discrepancies made in the ratepayers notes, and at the same time the Auditors be requested to schedule a list of what has been paid on roads, bridges ~~and~~ Salaries &c."

It was proposed and seconded by Councillors Sprutt and Smith respectively and resolved:—

That the Barnaby District Council in reply to the resolution contained in Mr Green's letter, request in order to examine into the same, that written statements "of mistakes & discrepancies made in ratepayers notes" be furnished to the Council, the same to be verified by signatures of those making complaint — the same to be sent in by May 17th at 10 a.m.

The meeting then adjourned to Saturday morning 17 May at 10 o'clock.
