A meeting of the Council was held time and place as above, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

It was reported that Mr. Cook had disregarded the resolution of the Council re trespass on Parkland. It was therefore proposed and seconded by Councillors Spott and Byrne respectively: That the excavation in the Parkland be filled up. Carried.

The Auditor's report was received and adopted.

The printed statements of Corporation Accounts for the year 1902 were presented as audited.

Revision of Voters' List.

The Council resolved itself into a Court of Revision of the Voters' List for 1903.

A communication was received from Geo Adams whose name was not on the Assessment Roll, claiming a vote. The claim was disallowed.

The name of Albert C. Johnson was struck off, he being recently deceased. The Court then adjourned.

The Council upon resuming adjourned to Monday January 12th at 6. pm.
