

## Burnaby Hall

Saturday October 10 1903 7 pm.

The Council met, time and place as above, there being present the Reeve in the chair, and Councillors Byrne, Rumble, Smith, Spott & Stride.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read and confirmed.

Tenders were opened for the construction of a bridge on Carbon road, as follows:-

James C. Allen	\$ 200 <sup>x</sup>
Wren Leonard	210 <sup>x</sup>
Joseph Osborne	185 <sup>x</sup>
W. H. Raeph.	190 <sup>x</sup>

On motion the contract was let to Joseph Osborne being the lowest tenderer.

The Club was instructed to write to the Mayor of the City of New Westminster and to the Reeve of Coquitlam asking that a Committee of each of their Councils meet a Burnaby Committee at the City Hall on Friday Oct-16<sup>th</sup> at 2.30 pm. re. dangerous crossing on North road, Sapperton.

The Reeve and Councillors Byrne & Smith were appointed a Committee re North road crossing with Councillor Spott as alternate member.

Mr Herbert Guley addressed the Council re West end of Junction rd. Crs. Smith and Spott were authorized to expend not more than \$100<sup>x</sup>.

Cr Spott was empowered to expend \$15<sup>x</sup> in the improvement of Boundary road.

Cr Byrne was authorized to call for tenders for graveling Higgins rd. Cost not to exceed \$50<sup>x</sup>.

The Council then adjourned to Saturday, October 17<sup>th</sup> at 2.30 pm.
