

Burnaby Hall, 13 June 1903.
2.30 pm.

At a meeting of the Council held today and place as above, all the members being present. The Report of the Clerk - the minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

Mr Evans attended to Kent road; but upon report that Mr J. Grant objected, the matter was again laid over.

Councillor Rumble reported that Mr Evans had signed the contract over for Bailey's burial. The Clerk was instructed to lay the facts before the Department of the Attorney-General.

Councillor Stude was given further notice re. Tilgham road.

Councillor Smith reported that North road to Alleville had been put into shape.

The Road-tax Collector reported that the new railway construction employees refused to pay road-tax. The Clerk & Councillor Spratt were appointed a committee to act & take immediate legal proceedings to collect.

It was resolved to call for tenders for 20 chains of corduroy on Johnson's road, Councillor Smith & Cliff to act.

Also for a fill in place of a bridge on N. Street road, 9 ft deep by 12 ft wide on top, & for recovering a bridge. Councillor Byers to prepare specifications.

The Debenture Company paid June 1st amounts, to \$750⁺ was passed & a cheque drawn in settlement.

The Council adjourned to June 27th, the accounts to be taken on that day.
