

Burnaby Hall, 13 June 1903.
230 p.m.

At a meeting of the Board held this day as above, all the members being present the Rec
is the Chair - the minutes of last meeting were
read and approved.

Mr Evans attended in Bent road; but was reported
that Mr J. R. Grant objected, the matter was again laid over.

Councillor Rutter reported that Mr Morris had
signed his powers over for Bailey's bridge. The bridge
was intended to lay the facts before the Department
of the Attorney-General.

Councillor Stode was given full power
Bridgeman road.

Councillor Smith reported that North road to
Maurice had been put into shape.

The Roads by Collector reported that the new
railway contractor employees agreed to pay road taxes.
The Rec & Councillor Spratt were appointed a committee
to act & take immediate legal proceedings to collect.

It was resolved to call for tenders for
20 chains of corduroy on Johnson road, Burnaby
South Cliff to act.

Also for a pile - fence or a bridge on
N. Stein road, 9 ft. deep & 12 ft wide on top, &
for recovering a bridge. Councillor Dyne to furnish specific.

The Debenture Account paid June 1st amounted to
\$750^{*} was passed to a clear draw - settlement.

The Committee adjourned to June 27th, the
accounts to be taken on that day.
