

Quincy Hall, 15<sup>th</sup> August 1903.

2.30 pm

The Council met pursuant to adjournment, time and place as above, the Revue in the chair, other members present being Councillors Byrne, Bliff, Plumble, Spratt and Stride.

The minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed. It was resolved :-

That the Clerk be authorised to attach the Common Seal of the Corporation to a partial discharge of Mortgage in favour of Mrs Anne Sandhill, there being ample security in her unencumbered premises.

Mr. Stride reported that he had engaged a man to brush the drainage ditch to Lot 53.

Tenders were received for repaving ~~the~~ <sup>Deer Lake</sup> rd as follows :- John Wolf \$70<sup>00</sup>, W. McMuray \$40<sup>00</sup> & Geo Bulman \$35<sup>00</sup>. The Contract was let to Geo Bulman to be completed within 6 weeks.

It was proposed and seconded by Councillors Byrne & Bliff respectively and resolved :-

That in future all Specifications shall contain a time limit clause, and a penalty of 1% per day of the tender for non-performance of contract within that limit.

A complaint from Miss Dundas to re Johnston rd. West end, was laid over.

Mrs. Hughes wrote complaining of the state of Fifth Avenue (Intercommunal) between 6<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Streets (City). Councillors Bliff, Stride and Plumble were appointed a committee to report.

Specifications were submitted for the repair of Hazard rd, and laid over.

Mr. Plumble was authorised to call for tenders for the repair of Smiths avenue, to be received by Aug 29<sup>th</sup>.  
Owing to the absence of C. Smith the two

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tenders received for the construction of a bridge over the Brunette on the Cambou rd. were laid as required.

The committee appointed to act as Milayson rd. were requested to do so before next meeting.

The Council arranged to meet in committee on Saturday Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8 a.m. in the City, in order to inspect Johnston rd, St. Pierre bridge and the Harzard rd.

Council then adjourned to Aug 29<sup>th</sup> at 2.30 p.m.
