

Burnaby Hall, 16 May 1903

2.30 pm

The Council met time and place as above, all the members being present, the Revere in the chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

The Revere reported the result of a meeting with the representatives of New Westminster City & Coquitlam Municipality re Brunette bridge on the North road, that the bridge had been closed to traffic, & that a new bridge would be necessary to cost about \$800, of which New Westminster would bear half cost, and Burnaby & Coquitlam $\frac{1}{4}$ each. Adopted.

Councillor Cliff reported re Avenue III that he had let a contract to John Ledger for 100 yds @ 50 per yd.

Councillor Spull & Rumble reported re Gravel, and it was resolved that Geo Sprung's tender be accepted for 250 cbrds of broken rock at \$2⁴⁰ per yd to be delivered where required on Hastings road, to Councillor Spull's order.

16th May 1903.

Councillor Byrne reported re North Star road bridge, & was allowed time for further report.

The Burnaby Revenue Bylaw 1903 was laid over.

Councillor Rumber reported that Mr John Waep's tender of \$70[±] for McKay road had been accepted.
re North road - gravelling.

The tenders were referred to the Inter-municipal Committee, the Club to furnish detailed statement of amount already expended on this road.

Councillor Stude was elected chairman, the Revs having to leave to meet the Mayor & Revs of New Westminster & Coquitlam respectively, re Bennett's bridge.

A petition was received from Messrs Wilson & Morris, to open out Kent road in Lot 6.

Councillors Olcott & Smith were appointed a Committee to act, the expenditure not to exceed \$30[±], & the road to be 15 chains long & 12 ft wide. The Club was instructed to write to Mr Wain regarding the fence.

Councillor Smith was authorized to obtain a load of lumber for repairs of bridges, etc.

Councillor Smith was allowed two weeks to report re North road to Colvill etc.

Councillors Stude, Rumber & Byrne were appointed a Committee re. Clearing drain ditch west of Vancouver St in Lot 29[±].

Councillor Byrne was authorized to have South road pushed out.

11th May 1903

Committee Reuben & Byrne were authorized to call
for tenders for making 20 chains of the Centre road N.E.
in Lot 99, to be in by next meeting. The road to be
16 ft. wide.

Mr Gummer's application for a loan of \$300⁺ was declined.

The meeting then adjourned to May 30th at 2.30 pm
