The Council met pursuant to adjournment, after the Court of Revision, as above, all the members present.

The Minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

Councillor Spratt was appointed chairman in the absence of the Reeve who had to leave before the proceedings were over.

A letter from Boguslaw's Council re completion of North road was referred to the Inter-municipal Committee with a request for haste.

It was resolved that Messrs Love & Russell be paid in full re Cambon road, less \$25⁰⁰ for damage made by loggers.

Also that Mr Love be paid in full for North rd.

Also that the Grant to the Royal Agricultural & Industrial Socy, be continued as before.

A report was read from the Medical Officer re Quarantine for Scarlet Fever at Mr Moynes, Central Park, and also the well & seats at St. Dennis School. The Club was instructed to notify the Secretary of the school.

Tenders were opened for spreading rock on Vancouver Rd W-11 as follows:-

John Dwy 39, Jones 40, W. Hatt Corp 44 per yd.

The Contract was let to Mr Dwy.

Councillor Stude was authorized to call for tenders for improving three sections of 10 chains each of Vancouver road.

The Meeting then adjourned to May 2nd @ 2.30 pm
