

Bunnaby Hall

31st Oct. 1903 2.30 pm.

The Council met time and place as above all the members being present the Reeve presiding.

The minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

Correspondence re. Sapperton crossing was read from the Premier and the President of the Council, and the proceedings at an informal meeting of Councillors of Bunnaby and Cozartlan held 24 Oct at Sapperton were reported. It was resolved that the Reeve and Councillors Olyff and Smith be a committee with full power to act re Sapperton Crossing.

A letter from the Medical Officer was read re quarantine cases and probability of a scarlet-fever epidemic, and it was resolved: That the Council will support the Medical Officer in any prosecution which he may

may initiate re. non-notice of contagious diseases and breaking quarantine.

Also that the C. C. be instructed to notify the heads of families under quarantine that the regulations must be observed under pain of prosecution and that if necessary a special constable would be appointed.

Mr. Allen reported he had been present by invitation at a meeting in New Westminster respecting the dredging of the Fraser river. The Council approved and his report was adopted.
