

Burnaby Hall

Monday, 5th October 1903, 2.30 pm.

At a Meeting of the Council, held time and place as above, all the members were present; the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read and confirmed.

The Committee re Hazard road, was empowered to expend not over \$25.00

Tenders were opened for the construction of Cambon road bridge as follows:—

James C. Allen \$ 120⁺

Joseph Osborne. \$ 2³⁰ per foot.

5th October 1903.

The tenders were referred to the Council or Committee.

Councillor Rumble was empowered to expend \$20^x on Cook rd, \$25^x in clearing ditches on Vanars. road, and to call for tenders for extension of the Centre road N. & S. in Lot 99.

Councillor Stude was empowered to expend \$15^x on Monclie rd.

Councillor Blyff was authorized to employ Eli Landen for the extension of Sixth street.

Councillor Smith reported that a contract had been let for the corduroying of North road, 25 chains at \$6⁵⁰ per chain with the option of further 24 chains at the same price.
