

## Bunnaby Hall

13 Aug 1904, 2.30 pm.

The Council met, time and place as above, all the members present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Councillor Stude reported re. Power House road, and he and Cr Byrne were empowered to draw up specifications and call for tenders for a road 18 ft wide, in three sections.

The Reeve reported he had purchased Subdiv. 29+30 Lot 95 for the extension of the McManus Hall Grounds, and a cheque for \$100.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>7</sub> was ordered to draw in payment thereof.

Mr Howland addressed the Council, and the Committee reported re Howland ditch. Laid over.

Cr Hill reported he had called for tenders re Deer Creek Bridge. Adopted.

The P.O. Electric Railway Co write asking for the line for their commercial wire posts, & suggesting 15 ft from the South side of the Vancouver road (between Bunnaby Junction and N.W. City) and Councillors Evans and Stude were appointed a committee to act.

The same Company write respecting gazetting the Pole line road, and asking for a draft of the proposed Bylaw. Laid over, the Reeve to act meanwhile re drafting Bylaw.

Mr R. B. Bay write stating that Capt. Inman had written them declining to sign the 2nd claim deed for portion of Royal Oak road. Filed.

Mr H. Lester write for permission to lay a water pipe under Moscrop road. Granted.

Mr Nicholson addressed the Council re Boundary road, and Cr Hill was empowered to have beaver dams cut and the road repaired. Tenders.
