

Bunbury Hall, 17 Sept 1904

2.30 pm.

At a meeting of the Council held here and place as above, all the members except Councillor Love, were present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Communications and Reports.

- 1 Royal Agric. & Indus^y Socy, enclosing tickets for the Provincial Exhibition, New Westminster. A vote of thanks was passed, to be conveyed by Clerk.
- 2 Thomas Beech, re cleaning ditch through Lot 53. Councillor Stude to act.
- 3 Re Lot 31. Mr J J Johnston addressed the Council. Referred to Council in Committee.
- 4 Br Love forwarded draft Specifications for repair of Cumberland road. Laid over.
- 5 Br Evans produced Specifications for repair of curb road at Bunetta bridge, North road. Laid over for report from Boguskin Council.
- 6 Further time was granted to Br Love to report re Latham road ditch.
- 7 Messrs Martin & Weart wrote claiming payment of fees for a Crown's inquest alleged to have been held by Dr. Munro re. Bailey deceased. Reeve and Clerk to act.
- 8 Mr Holland wrote re Holland ditch, alleging certain verbal promises made by members of preceding Councils. Referred to Council in Committee, Clerk to reply that Council is not bound by alleged verbal promises of past members.
- 9 The Reeve reported he had replied to Messrs Martin & Weart's letter re Peter J Johnson, but had not received any reply as yet. Approved.
- 10 A petition was received for the bushing of Hartings road between Clayton & Royal Oak roads. Br Stier to act.

11. The Revere reported that the Ab Electric Railway Co was willing to pay the cost of a bridge on the Pole line road, similar in construction to the Steel Creek bridge on Hartings road - also that the U.W.G. Ry Co wd pay half the cost of removing the knoll on North road and spreading it on the road between Brunette bridge & the crossing.

12. Br Evans reported re Barnett road repair and was empowered to act.

Tenders

Tenders were opened for the construction of about 15' ch of Cameron road as follows:-

w The lower tender was accepted.

Mr John Campbell addressed the Council re Murters on private property.

The Revere and Br Stiel were appointed a committee to interview Mr John St Spratt re repair of Boundary road adjoining Hartings Town site.

Councillors Byrne & Peumble were appointed a committee to report re Boundary road South, adjoining St. Vancouver Municipality.

w The Club was instructed to write to the Ab Electric Railway Co requesting them to move the new pole opposite Mr Prestin's house, 3 ft nearer the road line, as directed by Councillor Stiel before the ^{wires} lines were stretched. Also to notify it, that a serious accident, which might have been fatal, occurred owing to the track not being properly gravelled.

The Council then adjourned to Oct 1st at 2.30 pm

Br Byrne was empowered to call for tenders for brushing N. Main Rd.
