

Burnaby Hall, 21 May, 1904.

7.30 pm.

A Special Meeting of the Council was held, time and place as above, all the members being present except B. Love. The Reeve presided.

It was resolved that the Reeve and Councillors Hill and Byrne be a delegation of the Council to proceed to Victoria, to request the Government to grant \$200⁺ towards an illustrated advertisement of Burnaby in the "Farmer Advocate" and

That J. Carter - Cotton Mpp, the Mayor, & Chairman of the Board of Trade & Tourists Association of Vancouver and New Westminster be asked to accompany the delegation.

Councillor Rumble alone objected.

The Meeting then adjourned.
