

27 Aug 1904 2.30 pm.

The Council met pursuant to adjournment, time & place as above, all the members, except Mr Evans, being present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

A vote of condolence with Mr Evans in his recent bereavement, was passed, and ordered to be forwarded.

The opening of tenders for Taver Hamre Road & Jubilee road was laid over, only one tender being received.

Mr Howland again addressed the Council re Howland ditch; but no definite conclusion made.

27th August 1904

Councillor Cameron of Coquitlam, addressed the Council re North and Cameron roads.

The Reeve reported that the line of posts for the Ab Electic Commercial wire had been fixed at 9 ft. from the S. side of Vancouver road.

Further time was granted to Dr. Hoies to report re: Boundary road near Mr. Nicholson's land.

A communication was received from Messrs. Martin & Weart stating they had been retained by Mr. Peter E. Johnson of Central Park re. a ditch built across the Boulevard opposite his property, and asking that it be filled up. It was moved and seconded and laid over for further report.

"That Councillor Rumble be instructed to have the ditch across the Boulevard filled up in accordance with Messrs. Martin & Weart's request."

Councillors Rumble and Byrne to report next meeting.

Mr. Henry Hughes wrote re cleaning ditch on Latham road. Dr. Hoies to report.

Councillors Rumble and Byrne were instructed to prepare specifications re Boundary Road.

The Collector was instructed to advertise the Tax Sale in the ~~Daily~~ Columbian.

Councillors Stude and Rumble with the Reeve were empowered to act in regard to forcing the Municipal Tax funds.

The Council then adjourned to Saturday next, September 3rd at 2.30 pm.
