30 Jan 1904 2.30 pm.

The Council met pursuant to adjournment time and place as above, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

The Clerk was instructed to write to 5th Vancouver Council asking them to meet the Interim Com: re. Mercer's petition on the 20th Feb at 2.30 pm.

Councillor Stude was given further time to report re Tramway grading.

Mr Cook addressed the Council re clearing brush on the road opposite his gateway, and the clearing of a culvert. Laid over.

Councillor Pumble gave notice of his intention to introduce a Tax-Sale By-law.

The Council arranged to meet on Committee 4 Feb'y at 10.30 am. at Brunette Lodge Sapperton, and at 2 pm. at Councillor Love's residence.

On motion Councillor Stude was empowered

to employ a man to finish Mr Wolf's contract.

The Club was instructed to advertise in the Daily Columbian, World & News-Advertiser for applications for office of Assessor at \$125⁰⁰ salary, to be received before Feb'y 13th.

It was moved and seconded respectively by Drs Hill and Stude and carried that Mr Hearford be appointed Collector.
