4 June 1904, 2.30 pm.

The Council met after the rising of the Court of  
Session, all the members being present, the Reeve  
in the chair.

The Minutes of the meetings held May, 14<sup>th</sup> and  
May 21<sup>st</sup> were read and confirmed.

Mr. Wintermute addressed the Council re. a bridge.  
Referred to Commodore Love, Studd and Hales to report.

The Reeve and Councillors Evans & Stude were appointed a committee to interview Mr. W. G. Gummer re Columbus St., N. road.

Accounts re N. rd were laid over on account of Councillor Gummer's letter

14th June 1904.

The Reeve reported the result of the Inter-municipal Committee re North rd, viz. an extra of 920<sup>\*</sup> to the contract occasioned by the raising of the track V W of Rytes, Bus Lane & Common a committee re bridge approaches, and the Reeves <sup>the road between</sup> inspecting track & bridge & its regrading. Adopted.

Councillors Byrne & Shute were requested to draw up Specifications for repair of Booth road.

It was resolved that the owners be requested to subscribe half the cost of constructing Inman Avenue, estimated at \$12<sup>00</sup> per chain, to serve as a precedent on future applications. Mr C C Dennis's tender of gravel for Edmunds Street, at .65 per yd was accepted; as was also Mr Wren Leonard's tender of \$20<sup>\*</sup> for a cut on Canton Street.

The Quarterly Revenue Bylaw 1904 was read and passed, and laid over for reconsideration.

The Council then adjourned to June 18<sup>th</sup> at 2.30 pm.
