Declaration in re Municipal Elections Act - sec 80.

I Charles T Spott, Peter Byrne and we  
 Peter Byrne, Ober Stride, Jesse Love, Alex E Evans, Bernard

 each for himself do declare that I am a British subject  
 possessing the ~~same~~ qualifications by law required,  
 and that I am not in any way disqualified from  
 holding the office of a member of Council to which  
 I have been elected, and I have not, nor will have  
 while holding office, any interest, directly or indirectly,  
 in any contract or services connected with the  
 corporation of Burnaby, except such as I may  
 lawfully have under the provisions of the Municipal  
 Classes Act in that behalf. I have not by myself or  
 any other person, knowingly employed any bribery,  
 corruption or intimidation to gain my election, and  
 I will faithfully perform the duties of my office,  
 and will not allow any private interest to influence  
 my conduct in public matters.
