9 July 1904

2.30 pm.

The Council met time and place as above, all the members being present, except Councillor Evans on account of sickness, the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

The Reeve of South Vancouver addressed the Council re Boundary road, and it was agreed to join the S.V. Council in an expenditure of \$80[±] on the road South of West & Vancouver road, that Council to supervise the work. Also to meet the Intermunicipal Committee on Thursday July 14th at 10 a.m.

Mr F. R. Glover, Local Manager of the B.C. Electric Railway, also addressed the Council re the Light and Power Bylaw, and also the Pole line road. It was resolved that the Council is agreeable to gazetting

The Pole Line road, providing it be indemnified against any loss thereby.

Mr H. T. Corbrey also addressed the Council and offered 50 photographic views of different localities in the Municipality for \$20⁰⁰, to be exhibited along with the Provincial Exhibit at the Dominion Exhibit at Winnipeg, and for other purposes. *Land over.*
