

November 4. 1905.

At a meeting of the Council held at the Municipal Hall, on Saturday, Nov: 4<sup>th</sup> 1905 at 2.30 p.m. in pursuance of adjournment.

Present: Reeve Sprott (in the chair) Councillors Byrne, Stude, Love, Hill and Rumble.

- 565 Minutes: The minutes of meeting held on Oct. 28<sup>th</sup> 1905, were read and confirmed.
566. North Road Crossing. Minute 528 was ordered to be continued, the Clerk to write Mess<sup>rs</sup> Wilson Sinker & Co as to receipt of order.
- 567 Repair of Boundary Road. Minute 529 was ordered to be continued.
- 568 Tramway Sixth Street. Minute 530. Mr Hill's plan, with covering letter, was submitted, and the minute continued.
- 569 Hastings - Barnet Road. Minute 531 was ordered to be continued. The Clerk was instructed to advertise in the Advertiser and the Columbian that time for receiving tenders was extended to Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 570 Gunn Road. Minute ~~532~~<sup>560</sup>. Councillor Love submitted specification for making 40 chains, or thereabouts, of this road.  
Resolved: That tenders be called by advertisement for this work and considered on Nov: 18<sup>th</sup>.
571. Cost of preparing deeds &c. Minute 533. The Reeve reported as to his interview with the Solicitors.  
 As to mortgages the costs (exclusive of out of pocket expenses) would be upon

The report was received, and the Minute continued.

572 Royal Oak Road South through Lot 98. Minute 535. Councillor Stride brought in specification which was read and adopted.

Resolved: That tenders be called for making 19 $\frac{1}{2}$  chains (in two sections of 10 and 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  chains, to be in by the next meeting of the Council.

573. Capt. Inmans Deed. Minute 537 was ordered to be further continued for the clerk to ascertain whether Mr. O'Brien's deed for road allowance had been executed.

574 Tenth Avenue - City Limits. Minute 538 was further continued the Committee being authorized to call for tenders for presentation at the next Council meeting.

575 Mr. Trapp's assessment. Minute 539. The clerk submitted affidavit of Mr. Trapp shewing improvements done on his land prior to April 15. 1905. He further reported that he was holding Mr. Trapp's cheque for 1905 taxes until the 1904 were paid. Action as to the allowance of rebate was deferred until the whole of the taxes were paid.

- 575<sup>A</sup> Outlet from Armstrong Avenue. Minute 541 was further continued.
- 576 Byrne Road. Minute 542. The clerk submitted copy of the notice published in the B.C. Gazette giving detailed description of this road. He further reported that he had searched the old Minute Books but failed to find any record of an agreement for compensation to Mr Woollard.
- Resolved: That the clerk write Mr Woollard accordingly, and inform him that the Council are unable to entertain his proposal for compensation, and requesting him to remove his fence back to the line of the gazetted road.
577. Loan to Thos. Brocklebank. Minute 543. The clerk reported that this matter had not be proceeded with. Mr Brocklebank attended before the Council with a view to obtaining the loan at 6%.
- Resolved: That the clerk be requested to search the Minutes for the exact terms upon which loans have been granted, and to report to the next meeting
- 578 Drainage of Mr Lewis' property. Minute 544.
- Resolved: That the Reeve and the clerk be a Committee to secure an agreement to carry Minute 544 into effect.
- 579 Armstrong Avenue.  
Ditch Cumberland Road. Minute 546. Councillor Love brought in specification which was read and adopted. Tenders were authorized to be called for the work.
- 580 Ditch Hastings Road. Minute 547. Resolved: That Minute 547 be, and the same is hereby, rescinded.
- Resolved: That Mr Plester be employed to dig this ditch at \$27<sup>5</sup> per chain.

581. Power House Road. Minute 550. The plan of this road as surveyed by Mr. A. J. Hill was submitted. Mr. Hill pointed out that a much easier grade to the North Arm Road would be obtained to that afforded by the gazetted road, if the course of the old skid road ~~was~~ were followed.

Resolved: That the plan and report be received and that the Committee appointed for inspecting Walkem Road be requested to report upon the advisability of carrying out the suggestion made by Mr. Hill.

582 Mr. FitzLanders' complaint. Minute 552. The Committee appointed herein reported having visited the locality, and that they were of opinion that the Council were not responsible for the flooding of a portion of the complainant's land.

The report was received.

583. Bad place on Hastings Road. Minute 553. The work was reported to have been carried out.

584 Gravel Westminster - Vancouver Road. Minute 558. Councillor Stride submitted specification which was read and adopted.

A tender from Mr. Hatt-Cook for screened gravel at 65¢ per yard and unscreened at 50¢ per cubic yard, was submitted.

Resolved: That the tender of Mr. H. Hatt Cook be accepted.

585 Widening of Hastings Road. Minute 559. Councillor Hill brought in specification for filling in ditch on North side of Hastings Road from Johnson Road and digging new ditch so as to increase the width of the road, and clearing of South ditch.

Resolved: That the specification be adopted and tenders called for the work; that Mr. A. J. Hill be requested to supply a copy of the lines of the Hastings Road as surveyed by him; and that the Clerk ascertain whether the road has been gazetted.

586 Deed for Gunn Road. Minute 532. The deed of conveyance G. H. Bent to the Corporation of land required for road allowance in consideration of the sum of \$65, was submitted.

Resolved: That the deed be handed to the Solicitors for perusal and report and registration, prior to handing over the consideration money.

587 Fumigating apparatus. Minute 562 was further continued.
