Proposed Bridge across Second Narrows. Reeve Kealey of North Vancouver forwarded a letter asking for the Council's endorsement of a petition (copy of which he forwarded) to the Dominion Government that the Government would build a public bridge across the Second narrows for the use of railroads and vehicular traffic.

Resolved: That a similar petition on behalf of Burnaby be drawn up and sealed and forwarded to the proper authorities.

Burnaby Highways By-Law 1906. The above By-Law for ex-appropriating <sup>lands</sup> and gazetting highways throughout the Municipality was submitted and read a first time.

The Council went into committee and further enlarged and amended the By-Law.

The Council resumed and the amendments were reported, approved, and the By-Law read a Second time.

Resolved: That the By-Law be reconsidered and submitted for third reading on Saturday November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Resolved: That the clerk be instructed to inform Mr Justice Morrison that the Council, in default of evidence being deduced in opposition to the affidavit now before the Council, they will proceed on Saturday the 20<sup>th</sup> inst. to transfer the property to the person whose tender was the highest at the Sale of Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> ult., and that a meeting for that purpose would be held at the conclusion of the Auction Sale fixed for that day.
