

Sept. 15 1906.

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At a meeting of the Council held at the Municipal Hall, on Saturday, Sept. 15 1906 in pursuance of adjournment.

Present, Reeve Byrne, in the Chair, Councillors Griffin, Stride, Love, Cluff, Anderson and Rumble

1409

Minutes. The minutes of meeting held on Sept. 1st were read and confirmed.

1410

Ditch from Mr. Rabbits property. Referring to minute 1358, a letter from Mr. Jacob Zier was read stating that he had purchased 10 acres of Mr. Rabbits property and was dependent upon this ditch for his drainage.

The letter was held for consideration.

1411

Request for opening of Tenth Ave. Mr. Zier (see previous minute) asking that this road might be made Eastwards from Twelfth Street to enable him to have egress and ingress to his property.

This being an Intermunicipal road the matter was laid over for consideration.

1412

Slaughter House. Minute 1328 was continued.

1413.

Mr. Lee Leon's ditch. Minute 1360 was continued.

1414

Land Seymour Creek. Minute 1361. A letter from Messrs Harris & Bull was read stating that District Lot 955 was found to contain 195 acres instead of 160 acres, and asking for a cheque for \$87⁵⁰ being one third share of the extra purchase money.

Resolved: That the Reeve and the Chairman of the Finance Committee be, and they are hereby, authorized to sign a cheque for \$87⁵⁰ balance of purchase money; and that the Reeve and the clerk be authorized to arrange with Mr.

Robt Grant as to payment of his Commission thereout.

- 1415 Ditch from Deer Lake. Minute 1389 was ordered to be discharged.
- 1416 New Westminster's share of cost of Jenth Avenue. The clerk having reported receipt of cheque for \$125 on account of this work, the matter was laid over for Councillor Stride to see the Chairman of New Westminster Board of Works thereon.
- 1417 Tax Sale Properties. Advertisements. The clerk having reported that in consequence of an advance in terms made by the Vancouver Newspapers the detailed advertisement had been suspended, and that the rates now quoted by the World, Province, & Advertiser for the one weeks insertion would be \$60 each, while the charge for the Daily & Weekly Columbian would be \$50 for the full term, and the Daily News \$15 for the full term, it was
Resolved: That the suspension of the advertisements in the three Vancouver papers be approved and that the further arrangement for announcements therein be left with the Revere, & the ^{Councillor Rumble} clerk.
- 1418 East Vancouver Townsite. Minute 1392 was continued.
- 1419 Water Rights on Burrard Inlet. The Revere and the clerk were instructed to obtain the Solicitors advice as to what description of lands proposed to be resumed for road purposes was necessary.
- 1420 Telephone Poles on Hastings Road. Minute 1380. A letter was read from Mr. W. W. Kent stating that the Line foreman would examine as to condition of the poles, but that it was probable that the line of wires along this road would be discontinued. The letter was ordered to be filed.

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1421 Johnston Road. Messrs Herbert Gilley and Joseph Reichenbach addressed the Council asking for means of access to Messrs Gilley's camp for the conveyance of supplies.

Resolved: That the Board of Works be requested to meet Mr. Gilley on the Johnston Road on Wednesday next, and to report to the Council.

1422 Painting of Hall. Minute 1396 was reported as being proceeded with, and was discharged.

1423 Pole Line to Mr. Mr. Gregor's house. Minute 1397 Councillor Rumble reported that the poles had now been placed at the regulation distance from the fence line on Nelson Road, but that the discarded holes had not been properly filled in or the ground made good. The matter was laid over till the next meeting.

1424 Tramway matters. Minute 1399. The Local Manager Mr. Mr. Quarrie wrote that the matters should have attention as soon as possible, and that he had issued notices that the speed of 10 miles an hour should not be exceeded on Sixth Street hill.
The letter was filed.

1425 Road through Lot 40. Minute 1400 was continued for report.

1426 Mrs. Ward's Taxes. Minute 1401 was continued.

1427 Taxes on Lands held from the Crown. Councillor Rumble and the clerk were appointed a Committee to write the Lands & Works Department hereon.

1428 Mr. Kay, Road. Minute 1404. Councillor Rumble submitted specification which was approved.

The following tenders were received:-
 Mrs. John Wolfe 2⁵⁰ per chain, 8 chains \$ 20⁰⁰
 George Bulman for the whole \$ 30⁰⁰

Resolved: That it be left with Councillors Stride and Rumble to accept a tender from the above after seeing Mr Wolf

- 1429 Road Signs. Resolved: That this proposal stand over indefinitely.
- 1430 Electric Light poles. Mess^{rs} Cluff & Sons applied for location of poles on Third Avenue which is less than a chain wide. The matter was left in the hands of Councillors Stride, Love & Cluff for decision.
The clerk reported application of the B.C. Elect. Light Co for location of poles on Hastings Road to the residences of Mess^{rs} Gordon & Madell from Edmonds Street. They were referred to the regulation requiring a distance of 10 feet from fence line.
- 1431 Grants to Local Shows. Resolved: That the Reeve and the Chairman of the Finance Committee be, and they are hereby authorized to sign cheques for Central Park Exhibition Committee \$100⁰⁰ and New Westminster Provincial Fair Committee for \$50⁰⁰
- 1432 Cleaning of Hall. This was left with Couns. Stride.
- 1433 North Arm Road. Couns. Griffin was authorized to have bullock removed and to have ditch between Bridges 1 & 2 from New Westminster cleared.
- 1434 Road near Mr. Mandevilles. The Reeve with Councillors Griffin and Rumble were appointed a Committee to prepare specification and to call for tenders for about 6 chains of puncheon.
- 1435 North Road Councillor Cluff reported having had wash out made good, and his action was approved
- 1436 Dead Cow. Councillor Anderson was empowered to secure burial of dead cow.

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- 1437 Hastings Road. Ward 5. Councillor Anderson was authorized to have 2 chains of punchon relaid where required, and to have culvert cleared opposite Mr Sprotts property.
- 1438 V.W. & G. crossing. The Committee appointed re advertisements were asked to see Mr Woods, Secretary of the Railway Co as to cutting of wires & provision of Cattle guards at Cariboo Road crossing.
- 1439 Moscrop Road. Councillor Rumble was authorized to get out specification for improvement of this road between Smith Avenue & Inman Avenue.
- 1440 Adjournment : Resolved: That the Council stand adjourned till Friday evening next, the 21st instant at 7 o'clock for the purpose of receiving tenders for Land and other business.
