At a meeting of the Council held at the Municipal Hall on Saturday October 20 1906 in pursuance of adjournment.

Present: Reeve Byrne, in the chair, Councillors Griffin, Stride, Love, Anderson, and Rumble.

1496. Reserve price on Corporation Lands. Resolved (unanimously) That the reserve price fixed for Sale numbers 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 be reduced to Five dollars per lot in each instance, and that minute 1493 be amended accordingly.

1497. West half of West half of Dis. Lot 160.

Referring to minute 1494 the Clerk reported service by Messrs Baxter, Mc Lennan and Savage, Barristers, Vancouver, of the following proceedings:-

1. Injunction restraining the Council from dealing with the above named property

2. Writ of Summons against the Council at the suit of Mr Bertha Nickel for the purpose of setting aside the Tax Sale and subsequent proceedings affecting the above property on the ground of fraud and false representation.

3. Affidavit of William Savage in support of Injunction.

1498. Retention of Legal Adviser. Resolved:

That the Reeve, Councillor Griffin and the Clerk be appointed a committee to select Counsel and to authorize such Counsel to accept service of the proceedings on behalf of the Corporation, and generally to advise the Council, and to take such action, in this particular matter, as may be deemed by him and them to be necessary.

- 1499 Return of Deposit. Resolved: That the Clerk be authorized to return to Mess^r Thomson Bros. the cheque deposited by them.
- 1500 Condition of Hastings Road through Hastings Townsite.
At the instance of Councillor Anderson the Clerk was instructed to make representations to the Provincial Government as to the unsatisfactory condition of this road the same being extensively used by Burnaby ranchers.
- 1501 Direction for Poles. Mr Rummell of the B.C. & Ry Co having asked for instructions for location of poles along Westminster Road from Central Park Station, the matter was left in the hands of Councillor Rumble to deal with
- 1502 M^w Bailey's taxes. Resolved: That a sum of Ten dollars be donated to M^w William Bailey of Central Park to supplement amount subscribed elsewhere to enable her to pay her taxes and arrears.
