

February 26th 1906.

At a Special Meeting of the Council held, upon the call of the chair, at the Municipal Hall on Monday February 26. 1906 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: Reeve Byrne (in the chair) Councillors Griffin, Stride, Hill and Rumble.

871. Resignation of Councillor Evans. The clerk read a letter received on the 22nd inst. from Councillor Evans declining to accept the office of Councillor for Ward IV to which he had been elected by acclamation during his absence in England.

Section 83 of the Municipal Elections Act having been read, it was

Resolved: That the Council appoint Monday the 5th day of March between the hours of 12 o'clock noon as the day and hour for receiving nominations at the Municipal Hall; that the clerk be, and he is hereby, appointed Returning Officer; that he publish the necessary notices forthwith; and that in the event of a poll being necessary such poll be taken on Thursday the 8th day of March between the hours of 8 a.m and 4 p.m at the Municipal Hall.

872. Application from settlers. The Clerk reported receipt of a letter from Mess^{rs} Holbrook and Dutrie written on behalf of the settlers between Johnston Road and the V. W. & Y Railway asking permission to make a road along the roadway for which the contract was awarded to W^m Stevens as the Contractor was not proceeding with the work. They further asked that they might lay a track on the roadway and remove the timber, as by so doing the slashing would be effected.

Resolved: That Councillor Stride be asked to see W. Stevens as to the non fulfilment of his Contract, the time for completion of which

will expire on March 25; and that the clerk write a reply to Mess^{rs} Holbrook and Dutchie as to the non expiration of the contract time.

873. Mr. Sandersons complaint. Minute 865. The Revere reported result of the committees visit on Saturday last.

The Committee were given further time to enable them to endeavour to effect an arrangement between the property owners.

The Council then rose.
