

September 29th 1906

At a meeting of the Council held at the Municipal Hall, on Saturday, Sept 29th 1906 in pursuance of adjournment

- 1449 Minutes. The minutes of meeting held on Sept 15th and 21st were read and confirmed.
- 1450 Mr. Rabbitts request re Ditch. Minute 1410 was discharged the work having been completed.
- 1451 Mr. Lelion's ditch. Minute 1413, the clerk read proposed agreement which was approved.
Resolved: That the Reeve and clerk be, and they are hereby, authorized to affix the Common Seal to the Agreement when executed by Mr. Lelion.
- 1452 Land Seymour Creek. Mr. Robt Grant wrote saying he had received the Crown Grant for District Lot 957 agreed to be purchased by the Municipalities for \$1000 exclusive of timber.
Resolved: That the Reeve and the Chairman of the Finance Committee be, and they are hereby, authorized to sign a cheque for \$333³³ in payment of the Council's one-third share of the purchase money.
1453. New Westminster's Share of cost of 10' Ave.
Minute 1416. the clerk was instructed to issue a receipt on account.
- 1454 Tax Sale Properties. Referring to Minute 1417 and 1443, the further consideration of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of District Lot 160 was held over, Mr. Thomson having consented to retaining his cheque.

With respect to the unsold properties it was

- 1455 Resolved (Councillor Rumble dissenting) That the unsold properties be offered for Sale by Auction on Saturday, October 20th at the Municipal Hall at 2.30 p.m.
- 1456 Resolved: That the Clerk, as collector, conduct the Sale, and that he be authorized to advertise the same in the same papers as had published the previous list.
- 1457 Resolved: That the terms of payment be as before; but that a condition be added that the Deeds must be provided by the purchasers.
- 1458 Resolved: That the Council defer the question of what reserve price shall be placed on each property.
- 1459 Resolved: That no applications for the purchase of any of the properties by private sale be entertained.
- 1460 Resolved: That the deposit money of Mess^{rs} Robinson & Foulds be returned to them.
- 1461 Water Rights and Gazetting of Roads. Resolved: That the Council meet on Saturday, Oct 13 for the special purpose of proceeding with this business.
- 1462 Moserop Road. Councillor Rumble submitted draft specification which was approved, and he was authorized to call for tenders for the work. Same to be in by next meeting.
- 1463 Minutes continued; the following Minutes were carried forward:
1411. Opening of 10' Ave Eastwards from 12' St.
1412. Slaughter House
- 1420 Telephone Poles, Hastings Road.
1425. Road through Lot 40
- 1426 Mrs Wards taxes.
1434. Road near Mr Mandevilles
1438. V. W & Y. Crossing.

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- 1464 Mr Donald Ross's Taxes. Mr Ross appeared and explained that he entered ^{the Lease from the Government} into possession of his property in 1900 but was charged for arrears prior to that year.
Resolved: That the arrears previous to 1900 be wiped off the books.
- 1465 School Matter. Mrs Shannon wrote as to need for School at the Lake and the letter was referred to Mr Ross.
- 1466 Brush on Boundary Road. Mr Dubois having asked for brush to be cut from roadside, Councillor Rumble was requested to confer with Councillor Almas, of South Vancouver in the matter.
- 1467 Mr Bradburys Tax Sale Purchase. Mr Charles Bradbury wrote asking the Council to obtain confirmation of the Sale of the property he purchased and paid for at the 1904 Tax Sale.
Resolved: That a cheque be drawn in favour of Mr Bradbury for re-payment of purchase money and interest, and the letter and cheque be referred to the Solicitors.
- 1468 Careless Blasting. The clerk was instructed to write Mr A. H. Blair as to complaints of reckless blasting.
- 1469 Power House Road. The clerk to write Charles Burchell to finish last 1½ chain of road as per specification.
- 1470 Hastings Road. Couns. Anderson was authorized to have work done on portion of road near Mr Sprolls at a cost not to exceed \$13.
- 1471 Ditching. Resolved: That an appropriation

be made to each Councillor sufficient to have ditches cleared out prior to wet season.

1472 Sale of Lands by Provincial Government. Councillor Rumble drew attention to a statement in the Vancouver Province to the effect that the Council were retarding sale of land by the Government, and the clerk was instructed to forward ^{to the papers the} correspondence between the Government & the Council.

1473. Adjournment. Resolved: That the council adjourn till Saturday, Oct. 6th at 2.30 p.m. being pay day.
