At a meeting of the Council held at the Municipal Hall on Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup> 1906 pursuant to adjournment

Present: Reeve Byrne in the Chair  
Councillors Giffin, Stride, Love, Cluff, Anderson and Rumble.

- 1474 Minutes. The Minutes of Meeting held on September 29<sup>th</sup> 1906 were read and confirmed.
- 1475 Mr. Lelions agreement. This matter was reported as complete.
1476. Land Seymour Creek. Minute 1452 The Reeve reported payment of share of purchase money to Mr. Grant whose commission would be paid by the Vendor.
- 1477 Sale of Properties. Minute 1454, the Clerk was instructed to obtain Mr. Thomsons consent, if possible, to retention of cheque for deposit on the W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Dis. Lot 160.  
The arrangements for advertising the Sale by Auction were left in the hands of the Reeve and Clerk.
- 1478 Moscrop Road. The following tenders were submitted:-

- Resolved: That the tender of Mark Mills be, and the same is hereby, accepted.
- 1479 Grant of Land for Road appropriations. Capt Inman wrote confirming his offer of land on the North & East sides of Dis. Lot 34.

- 1480 Tax Sale Deeds. The Solicitors wrote that they saw no reason why deed should not be granted to Mr Wallace for Land purchased at 1899 Tax Sale.  
The letter was filed.
- 1481 Application from Mr Doran. The clerk reported application by Mr Doran, owner of the Mill on Deer Lake-side to pile lumber for shipment on road allowance opposite the B. C. E. Ry siding to the East of Hastings Road on Edmonds Street, also for permission to deposit saw dust on Pole Line Road between his Mill and Hastings Road.  
Resolved: That the requests be granted subject to the supervision of Councillors Anderson & Love.
- 1482 Crossing at Cariboo Road. Councillor Rumble reported having seen the Managing Director of the V. W. & F. Railway with reference hereto, and the clerk was instructed to write the G. N. Road Superintendent as suggested by the Director.
1483. Mrs Ward's taxes. The Solicitors wrote saying Mrs Ward's Solicitors had asked for further time for payment, and they were authorized to give a reasonable extension.
- 1484 Pole Line Road. Councillor Cluff was authorized to employ a man for a week in repairing this Road. He was also authorized to accept the tender of Thos. Haddon for 8 chains of puncheon on Bainbridge Road.
- 1485 Vancouver Road. Councillor Stude was empowered to act in the matter of road improvement at or near the site of the Gilley Shingle Mill.
