1662 Woollard v Burnaby. Minute 1657 was continued,

the weather having prevented the work being carried out.

1663. Mr Bailey's children. Minute 1639. A further letter from Dr. Walker was received and laid over for consideration at the next meeting.

1663. Government road allowances. Minute 1641 was ordered to be continued

1664 Nelson Road. Wet places. Minute 1645 was continued for report.

1665 Absence of Councillor Griffin. Reports were made of the serious condition of Councillor Griffin, and the following resolution was drawn for submission to the meeting of Electors to be held this day:-

That this meeting of the Electors, and of the Municipal Council, has received with deep concern the report of the serious illness of their esteemed representative, and colleague, Mr. Marcus S. Griffin whose presence is sadly missed by them on this occasion, and they desire the clerk to convey to him an expression of their heartfelt sympathy with him in his illness, and their earnest hope that he may speedily recover therefrom.

The resolution was adopted

1666. Roads resumed on Dist. Lot 212. Two letters from Mess^{rs} Hope Gravelly & Co^o protesting against the Gazetting of road allowances on each side of Dis. Lot 212 were read, and laid over for consideration.

1667 Foreshore rights on Burrard Inlet. A letter was read from the Minister of Marine and Fisheries Ottawa reporting that Mess^{rs} John R Reid and James R. Turner of Vancouver had applied for foreshore rights in front of the Westerly, 26.24 acres of Dist. Lot 188, Group I, and asking if the Council knew of any reason why the application

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should not be acceded to.

Resolved: That the clerk be instructed to reply saying that, with the exception of the 33 feet road allowance on the West side of the East boundary line of the said Dist. Lot 188, already resumed by the Council, they saw no objection to the application being granted.

1668 Capt. Inmans road allowances. A letter was read from Capt. Inman upon the question of road allowances on Dis. Lot 33, and the same was laid over for consideration at the next meeting.

1669 Advertisement Rate. A letter from the Westminster Daily News quoting a rate for Corporation Adverts was referred to the incoming Council.

1670 Foreshore rights to Street Ends. Referring to Minute 1393 as to water rights on Burrard Inlet it was

Resolved: That the clerk prepare and forward to the Department of Marine and Fisheries 4 plans and 4 copies of the By-Law as required, and that he make application for the foreshore rights of the Street ends to be granted to the Corporation.
