At a Meeting of the Council held, in pursuance of adjournment, on Saturday, April 27, 1907 at 8 o'clock p.m.

Councillors Skinner, Stride, Cliff, Anderson, and Rumble.

1956. Assessment Roll 1907. The Clerk as Assessor returned to the Council the Assessment Roll for 1907 and took oath before the Reeve as to its having been compiled according to Statute.

The Gross value of the properties were shewn to be \$2,165,124.

The exemptions amounted to \$102,595.

1961. School Provision. Mr Ross, Chairman of the School Board attended, unofficially, as to deputation that had waited upon him from the settlement beyond Burnaby Lake asking for provision of a school and it was understood that should the School Board find it necessary to establish a school to serve this locality the Council would advance a sum of \$500 to purchase, and clear, a site for the same provided that the amount should be included in next years estimate of extraordinary expenditure.

1962 Removal of Watertrough from Bridge, Hastings Road. Councillor Anderson having reported removal of watertrough instructions were given for the Constable to trace the same and prosecute the offenders.

1963 Office Assistant. Minute 1915. The clerk reported that Joseph Collins had notified him of his acceptance of the position upon the terms named.

1964 Adjournment. Resolved: That the Council adjourn till Saturday, May 4th at 2.30 p.m. being pay days
