

August 30 1907.

At a Meeting of the Council, held in pursuance of adjournment, at the Municipal Hall on Friday, August 30 1907

Present. Reeve Byrne, in the chair; Councillors Spratt, Stride, Love, Cliff, Anderson, and Rumble.

2296 Minutes. The Minutes of Meeting held on Aug. 17. 1907 were read and confirmed.

2297 Burnaby Sinking Fund By-Law. Minute 2223 was continued.

2298 Tenth Ave West. Minute 2265. The Committee reported that the City Council of New Westminster had agreed to co-operate in the opening up of the Avenue, and a specification of the work was read and approved. Tenders had been invited for this day, by advertisement.

Only one tender being to hand, it was Resolved: That the time for receipt of tenders be extended till Saturday next.

2299 Trapp Road. Minute 2268 was continued so far as relates to Secs. 3 & 4.

3000 Extension of 4<sup>th</sup> Street. Minute 2270. Couns. Love read specification which was approved and tenders called for next meeting.

3001. Constable for Barnet. Minute 2271 was continued Mr de Pencier reporting that he had not yet made a selection.

3002 Further Criminal Offences. Minute 2272. The Reeve reported that a man named Thos. Henry Brookes had been held up by an armed robber at a shack off North Arm Road, near the end of South Road and robbed of 1<sup>50</sup> from

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his person. Immediately the offence took place the whole of the police officers of surrounding districts were notified. He had offered a reward of \$50 for the apprehension, or such evidence as would lead to the conviction, of the perpetrator. He had also engaged the services of Mr Alex<sup>r</sup> K Farquharson, of Central Park, as special constable and directed a thorough search to be made throughout the Municipality.

It was further reported that Constables Ralph and Farquharson had that day captured a man named John Wilson living in a shack near the Chinese camp on Hastings Road West, and found in his possession the watch <sup>stolen from</sup> lost by Mr Sommers' house, a number of firearms, a strap stolen from Central Park Station, and a quantity of articles believed to be stolen. The man confessed to the highway robbery from the person of Thos. Henry Brookes. He would appear before the local justices tomorrow.

Resolved: That the steps taken by the Reeve be, and the same are hereby, adopted and approved.

3003. Vancouver Road by Roberts Road. Minute 2274. Further time was applied for and granted.

3004 Road to Pipers Mill. Minute 2275 was continued

3005 Road Lot 87. Minute 2279. Couns. Love read specification which was approved, and as amended were accepted by the persons tendering & The following tenders were received

Resolved: That the tender of Mess<sup>rs</sup> Dow & Ledger for Sec. 1 and culvert be accepted and that section 2 stand over.

3006. Royal Oak Road. Minute 2282 Further time was granted for this work.

3007 Minutes continued.

2219. Waterworks. The plan shewing position of settlers' houses was reported to have been forwarded.

2188. Tenth Ave. Government portion. The Board of Works were granted further time.

2231. Brunnette River. further time.

2241. Vancouver Road. Gravel.

2288. W. Blaytons loan. Minute discharged the loan having been repaid.

3008 Continuation of Royal Oak Road. Minute 2289. Councils. Stride was authorized to bring in specification for a 12 foot road to Mr. J. Gray's property.

3009 Poles on Nelson Road. Minute 2291. Upon the recommendation of the Board of Works, the poles for electric light were directed to be placed on the same line as existing poles.

3010 Fell on Hastings Road. Minute 2292. Further time was granted herein.

3011 Fence on Boulevard. Central Park. Minute 2293. The present owner of the property was reported to be Mr. Chaffey, and the clerk was instructed to write accordingly.

3012 North Road crossing. Minute 2294. The Reeve was requested to ask for a copy of the finding of the commission.

3013 Glen Road. Mr. Keeper asked permission to cut and burn all brush on road allowance Lot 33 and for so doing that he be permitted to cut and carry away the timber standing on the reservation.

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Resolved: That Couns. Rumble be requested to prepare specification of work entailed in clearing the roadway.

3014 Tenth Avenue. The accounts between New Westminster Council and this Council were referred to Couns. Stude and the Clerk.

3015 Brushing North Road. Mr. Willshire wrote asking for this work to be completed. The Clerk was instructed to write Coquitlam Council asking that their side of the Road may be done, and Couns. Love was requested to have Burnaby portion completed.

3016 Station Buller Road. Mr. Hatt Cook having written asking the Council to apply for a station at this point the Clerk was instructed to write the B. C. E. Ry.

3017 Mr. Hatt Cooks claim for evidence. A letter from Mr. Hatt-Cook applying for balance of his claim, was read, and the Clerk was instructed to reply that the amount paid was considered fair remuneration for his services, and in accordance with scale since adopted.

3018 Pollution of Stream. Mr. C. J. Piper wrote complaining of pollution of stream running through Lot 40 by Messrs Gilley Bros' camp, and the matter was referred to the Board of Health with power to act.

3019 Proposed road Lots 152 & 153. Messrs Wilson & Lobleigh wrote asking the Council to take over a strip of land 33 ft wide between Blocks 10 and 11 for a road allowance as they desired to subdivide their properties.

Resolved: That the application be referred to the Board of Works for report.

3020 Plan of District Lot 189. Mr. J. C. Keith forwarded

plan for approval.

Resolved: That the plan be referred back for road allowances gazetted by the Council to be shown thereon.

- 3021 Plan of D. Lot 186. Mess<sup>rs</sup> Mc Kenzie & Robertson submitted plan but as the roads running North and South were not continued to the water at distances of 600 feet apart, the plan was referred back.
- 3022 Plan of Dis. Lot 116. Mess<sup>rs</sup> Mc Kenzie & Robertson submitted plan hereof as per sketch already approved  
Resolved: That subject to the conditions of the Maps Approval By. Law the plan be approved and signed by the Reeve.
- 3023 Work authorized in Ward I. Couns. Spratt was authorized to have ditch cleaned out and the puncheon repaired on Walkem Road applied for by F. Mandeville.
- 3024 Brushing Hastings Road. Couns. Anderson was authorized to have brush cut from Still creek westwards for a distance of about 140 chains.
- 3025 Request for Boulevard clearing. W. Curtis who is proceeding with laying out a Nursery on a portion of the Welch property Lot 87 asked for the boulevard to be cleared. The matter was laid over for consideration.
- 3026 Hauling Corduroy. Couns. Love was authorized to have corduroy hauled from 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave for use on Gunn Road.
- 3027 Nelson Road. Couns. Rumble was authorized to have Nelson Road regraded and to employ day labour for this purpose, and also in cooperation with Couns. Stude to procure 25 yards of gravel.
