

Saturday April 18<sup>th</sup> 1908.

At a meeting of the Council held in pursuance of adjournment on Saturday April 18<sup>th</sup> 1908 at the Municipal Hall

Present Reeve Byrne in the chair Councillors Farguharson, Hyde, Cliff, McKee, Anderson and Rumble

492. Application for Road. W Dougall owner of lots 8 & 9 Block 1 D.L. 90 South made application for road which was referred to councillors Cliff & Anderson to bring in report.
493. Subdivision of Lot 4 D.L. 152 & 153 W Kiefer wrote asking his position with Council with regard to his property which he was subdividing as the Junction Road which bounded his property was only 33 feet wide. Referred to a committee consisting of councillors Farguharson, Rumble & the Reeve.
494. Telephone Poles, Minute 472 W Hodges representing B.C. Telephone Co. asked permission to place poles on the North side of Hastings Road owing to there being already poles carrying high tension wires on the other side. Resolved that the Council would be unwise in granting this privilege thus blocking both sides of the road & councillors Cliff & Anderson were to meet W Hodges on the road to endeavour to arrange a settlement of the matter.
495. Block 20 D.L. 152 & 153 W Buckall asked leave to withdraw offer of land for highway.
496. Loans W John Sinclair Letter from W Sinclair read applying for loan of \$500.  
Resolved that the Council lend to John Sinclair of Central Park the sum of \$500 from the Sinking Fund the repayment of which together with interest at 7 per cent per annum being

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secured by a first mortgage on the  $W\frac{1}{2} + E\frac{1}{2}$  of Blk  
H D.L. 38 containing 10 acres of land more or  
less the same being assessed according to the last  
revised assessment Roll at \$1800 together with  
improvements & further that the Clerk publish a  
copy of this resolution by placing on the Notice  
Board for one week.

- 500 Rose Avenue Specification for grading 4 chains was approved and Councillor Farguharson was authorized to call for tenders
- 501 Vancouver Road Minute #78. Tender of W<sup>m</sup> Woolf for ~~hauling~~<sup>spreading</sup> rock at 70 cents a yard was accepted 40 yards of rock to be spread. Councillor Stride was authorized to hire team for hauling same
- 502 Vancouver Road Central Park Tender having been received for spreading rock on that portion of the road lying in Ward 6 the matter was referred to Councillor Rumble & the Road Foreman
- 503 Booth Road Minute #76 Specification as read was approved & tenders were called for the work in two sections of 10 chains each
- 504 Snake Hill (North Arm Road) reported that W<sup>m</sup> Cameron on behalf of committee appointed by Coquitlam Council to inspect had recommended that tenders be called for regrading. Resolved that \$100 be spent on the improvement of Snake Hill. Specification for regrading 9 chains was approved and subject to approval of Coquitlam tenders were to be called
- 505 Hastings Road Councillor Anderson submitted specifications which were approved & tenders were called for the work
- 506 Gunn Road Specification for bridge Gunn Road was referred to committee of Councillors Bliff Anderson the Road Foreman & the Reeve. Councillor Bliff was granted permission to engage 2 men & team for two days to mend Road.
- 507 Gravel Pit Councillor Rumble read letter from W<sup>m</sup> Lobley with regard to purchase of gravel on his property. Resolved that Council accept W<sup>m</sup> Lobley's offer & pay him 50 cents per yard up to 250 yards.

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- 508 Tenders were also ordered to be called for hauling 100 yards from Central Park to Smith Avenue
- 509 Trafalgar Road Specification of Councillor Rumble was approved & tenders were called for the work
- 510 Government Grant North Road Resolved that Councillors McKee & McKeever interview W. Manson at W. Ballou's office in reference thereto
- 511 Tenders. Resolved that the successful tenderer be notified from the office & that copies <sup>of the same</sup> be mailed from office of specifications to Councillor for Ward & one copy to Road Foreman
- 512 Assessment The clerk asked for an extension of one week in order to complete the Roll
