At an adjourned meeting of the Council held on Monday April 27th 1908 at 7:30 p.m.
Present Reeve Byrne Councillors Farguharson Stride Cliff McKee, Anderson & Rumble

- 515 Assessment Roll. The assessment Roll was returned to the Council showing a total net Assessment of \$1665539 as against \$1611789 for 1907 being an increase of \$53750.
- 516 Court of Revision Moved by Coun. Cliff seconded by Coun. McKee that the Assessment be received & that the annual Court of Revision be held on Saturday May 30th 1908 commencing at 10 o'clock in the forenoon at the Municipal Hall & that same be advertised in the B.C. Gazette Columbian World & other ^{advertiser}
- 517 Constitution of Court Resolved that the following members of the Council are hereby constituted to sit as a Court of Revision. The Reeve Councillors Farguharson Cliff McKee & Rumble
- 518 Telephone Poles. Communication from Telephone Co. for permission to place poles on the North side of the road & Councillor Cliff reported having met Mr. Hodges as arranged. Resolved that a Committee consisting of Councillors Stride Cliff Anderson & the Reeve should interview the Company & Clerk instructed to write making appointment.
- 519 Bulwer Boundary Road C.M.B. South Vancouver wrote making appointment to meet committee on the Boundary Road next Saturday May 2nd. Resolved that Councillors Farguharson & Rumble be appointed to attend
- 520 Nursery Road Councillor ~~Cliff~~^{as above} reported blocking of this road by Fraser Valley Nurseries Ltd. Resolved that Clerk be instructed to notify them to remove same

- 521 Blocking of Westminster Road Councillor Rumble reported having issued summons to compel the removal of boardwood from the highway near Central Park Station
- 522 Government Grants Reports were received from Councillors McKee & Rumble & Yarquharson re Snake Hill, Jubilee Road & Rose Avenue & clerk instructed to write Commissioner Lands & Works asking their cooperation in these matters
- 523 Youth Ave (Intermunicipal) Councillor Yarquharson reported completion of 1st & 2nd Sections between 14th & 20th Streets & it was arranged that he should meet Road Foreman of city of New Westminster to inspect work.
- 524 Fences on highways Councillor Cliff reported encroachment on highway of W. J. Allen's fences & clerk was instructed to notify him to remove same
- 525 W Geo Naud's application Minute 314. The Reeve reported having met Mr Tupper of McPhilips Tupper & Lawson & it appeared that the water had damaged property
- 526 adjournment Resolved that the Council adjourn until Saturday May 2nd 1908
