

Friday June 11<sup>th</sup> 1909.

An adjourned meeting of the Council held in the Municipal Hall on Friday June 11<sup>th</sup> 1909. Present His Worship The Reeve Councillors McGregor, Stride, Bliff, Amos, Nel and Silver.

The Minutes of the meeting held on May 28<sup>th</sup> 1909 were read and confirmed.

1563. Board of Trade. A deputation of the Board of Trade consisting of W. J. Trapp and W. Gilley waited on the Council with regard to the permanent improvement of the Vancouver and Hastings Roads. suggesting that the Board would be pleased to lend their assistance in any way. The Reeve in reply stated that the matter had been under the consideration of the Council and their intention was to put the roads in first class condition and a By law was being submitted to the ratepayers to include an expenditure of \$25,000 on each of these roads.

1564. Rose Avenue. W. Trapp stated that he had instructed Hong Joe to place corduroy on Rose Avenue last fall the same being impassable and asked Council to reimburse the cost of same.

North Road. Councillor Cameron attended with reference to the portion of the North Road so that Burnaby would be responsible to keep up a certain portion only and the matter was referred to the Intermunicipal North Road Committee to meet on the Brunette River Bridge at a time to be appointed.

1565. W. McKe's application. minute 1542. W. McKe wished to know whether the Council intended to put gravel on the road as he had requested & the matter was referred to the same Committee as in last minute.

1566. Plans of subdivision. Mr Forbes attended with plans of subdivision, but as same were in 33 foot lots the Council declined to look at same.
- Plans of Blocks 16 to 20 D.L. 93 & Blocks 1 and 2 D.L. 157 were referred to Plan Committee
1567. W. Welsshire's fence. Minute 1550. W.C.W. Welsshire wrote stating that owing to misunderstanding he did not receive notice until a portion had been taken down and crop exposed to damage by stock & suggested to Councillor Cliff that he be authorized to slash windrow. Referred to Councillor Cliff to adjust.
1568. Road loan By law. W.C.W. Welsshire wrote with reference to expenditure on North Road and to know what portion of Government Grant would be available also with regard to expenditure on Gunn, Johnston and Barnet Roads, and partition of North Road. Referred to Intermunicipal Committee.
1569. Seventh Avenue. Mr J. S. Pepin and J. Trenary wrote requesting Seventh Avenue to be opened 10 chains south from Sixth Street. Referred to Councillor Cliff.

 Government accordingly.

 to his property. Resolved that matter lay over  
 pending the permanent improvement of the road.

Councillor McGregor reported having seen W Carter Cotton M.P.P with regard to a grant for the continuation of the Boundary Road and he said he would recommend a grant for this purpose. Moved and seconded that the report be received.

1591. Loans from Sinking Fund. minute 1464. The Committee having reported favorably on the loans to Mr John Green & Mr Robert Trail it was

Resolved That the Council lend to John Green of Central Park the sum of Four hundred Dollars (\$500) from the Sinking Fund for a period of three (3) years, the repayment of which sum together with interest thereon at the rate of six per centum per annum, payable half yearly being secured by a first mortgage on

real property held and used for farming purposes by the said John Green and described as Lots 4 and 15 in Block One (1) being a subdivision of a portion of District Lot Ninety Four (94) Group One (1) New Westminster District, the same being assessed together with improvements thereon at the total sum of One thousand six hundred and fifty Dollars (\$1650) according to the last revised and corrected assessment Roll of the Municipality provided that the dwelling house and buildings be insured in the sum of Five hundred Dollars (\$500) at least in the name of the municipality.

Resolved That the Council lend to Robert Traill of East Burnaby the sum of Three hundred Dollars (\$300) from the Sinking Fund for a period of three years, the repayment of which sum together with interest thereon at the rate of Seven per centum per annum payable yearly being secured by a first mortgage on real property held and used for farming purposes by the said Robert Traill and described as Lots Three (3) and four (4) in Block seven (7) of District Lot Twenty seven (27) Group One (1) New Westminster District the same being assessed together with improvements thereon at the total sum of Six hundred Dollars (\$600) according to the last revised and corrected assessment roll of the Municipality provided that the dwelling house and buildings be insured in the sum of Three hundred Dollars (\$300) at least in the name of the municipality.

Resolved that the Reeve and Chairman of Finance be authorized to sign cheques for \$500 and \$300 from the Sinking Fund

1597 Fraser Valley Nurseries Ltd. Letter was read from Fraser Valley Nurseries requesting permission to erect sign at Edmonds Station, also to know what settlement the Council would make in regard to land resumed on the Hastings Road.

Moved and seconded that no objection

be taken to erection of sign provided same did not exceed 12 x 18 inches and that Hastings Road matter be laid over until receipt of final report from W Cleveland.

1593. W J Ashworth's application minute 1484. Councillor Stride recommended the opening of Oxford Road & tenders were called to be in at next regular meeting.
1594. Subdivision of D.L. 85. W Sheriff from W.A.J. Heil again presented plans of subdivision of portions of Lot 85 showing boulevard on the shores of the lake which the owners were willing to give provided adjoining owners did the same and to know if Council would guarantee that adjoining owners did so. The Reeve reported that he thought that it was a matter for arrangement between the owners affected.
