

Wednesday February 17th 1909.

A Special meeting of the Council was held in the municipal Hall on Wednesday February 17th at 1 o'clock p.m. The following members were present His Worship Reeve Byrne Councillor Stride, Cliff Amos Hill and Silver.

- 1224 Hastings Road. A Deputation consisting of C. F. Spott, C. R. Jordan, J. W. Macey, Edgar Spott and A. Theperley waited on the Council on behalf of property owners in the Burnaby Lake District and wished to know whether the Council were willing to put a bylaw before the ratepayers for the improvement of the Hastings Road at an estimated cost of \$24000 on the basis of their bearing one-third of the cost, the remaining two-thirds to be borne by a special rate on all property owners within half a mile of each side of the road.
 Resolved that the matter be referred to the Reeve & W. Spott representing the owners affected.
- 1225 Vancouver Road. Resolved that tenders be called for delivery of 500 yards of rock between Edmonds Station and Royal Oak Road and 500 yards between Royal Oak Road and the Central Park, also 500 yards on the Hastings Road between Deer Lake Creek and Lakeview School House, and that tenders be in at next regular meeting.
1226. W. D. W. Cumming. minute. Councillor Hill recommended the brushing of Roberts Road a distance of 5 chains for a width of 6 feet and 24 feet from the north side of the road limit also the extension of the Ledger Road ditch at an estimated cost of \$6. Resolved that these reports

1227. Pole Line Road. The Road Foreman was instructed to stake out a ditch to carry the water from the Pole Line down to Deer Lake.
- 1228 Sixth Avenue. Coun. Cluff was authorized to call for tenders for slasting 6th avenue the full width of the road allowance between 4th & 6th Streets.
- 1229 Cracked rock. The Board of Works were authorized to make enquires of the cost of cracked rock per yard in lots of 500 yards.
