

Monday July 26th 1909.

At an adjourned meeting of the Council held in the Municipal Hall on Monday July 26th at 7.30.

Present His Worship Reeve Byrne councillors
McGregor, Stride, Cluff, Amos Hill and
Selous.

1427 Road Machinery moved by councillor
Cluff seconded by councillor McGregor
that the following machinery be purchased.

- 1 Waterous Double cylinder roller
- 1 No 4 Jaw crusher.
- 1 Steel grader.
- 1 Cut and w reach steel sprinkler.
- 1 Pick Plow.

Moved and seconded that Reeve & Clerk
be authorized to sign contract for the above.

1428 Crushed rock Tender of Gillis Bros was received
for hauling rock at \$3⁰⁰ per yard

Moved by councillor Cluff seconded
by councillor McGregor that tender be accepted
& that he be instructed to haul rock until order
cancelled

1429. Gunn Road moved by councillor Hill seconded
by councillor Stride that councillor Cluff be
authorized to hire team & men to place gravel on
road

Edmonds Street Tender of G. J. Osburne for
finishing contract on Edmonds Street which
had been left by W. Sinclair at \$60 was
received. Moved and seconded that matter
be referred to councillor Stride to let contract.

1430. Hastings Road Tenders were called for
slashing road full width from Royal Clayton

Road to Boundary Road in sections of 20 chains.

1731 Accounts. The following accounts were passed

S. J. Osborne \$50.00

Moved and seconded that the Reeve and Chairman of Finance be authorized to sign cheques in payment of same.

1732 Road Loan Debentures. The Clerk was instructed to advise that the Council were prepared to sell full amount of issue.

The Clerk was instructed to get prices on lithographing Debentures.

1733 Ledger Road. Moved and seconded that Stuart Ledger be allowed to place 25 yards of gravel on Ledger Road at \$1⁰⁰ per yard subject to his placing rock on the Road as far as Hastings Road

1734 Subdivision plans. Letter from Wade Wheeler & W. Quarrie was received stating that they were in receipt of letter from Provincial Secretary stating that Executive Council had refused to approve subdivisions on which appeal had been taken. Moved and seconded that same be received.

1735 Piper Road. The placing of culvert at a cost of \$25 on the Piper Road was left in hands of Council's Amos.

1736 Adjournment The Council then adjourned until Friday August 13th 1909 at 7:30 pm
