

Tuesday October 18th 1910

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held in the Municipal Hall on Tuesday October 18th 1910,
Present His Worship Rave Byrne
Councillors Mc Gregor, Stride, Goldicos
W. K. Hill and Rumble.

1322. The Minutes of the meeting held on Saturday October 8th were read and approved.

Communications were received from

1323. Burrard Lumber Co. with reference to Ross Avenue. Referred to the Engineer and Councillor for the Ward with power to act up to \$100.

1324 W. S. Rose Hon Sec Ward 2 Ratepayers Association requesting Council to provide better method of Police Patrol on Vancouver Westminster Road with reference to automobiles speeding. Referred to Police Committee with power to act.

1325 Dominion Finance Co. with reference to widening of New Westminster Road from Knight Road through to the waterfront to 99 feet also suggesting renaming of road "Union Avenue".
Resolved that a reply be sent that the Council endorses the idea.

1326. Joseph Collins resigning his position as assistant clerk
 Moved by councillor W. Gregor seconded by councillor Stride that W. Joseph Collins resignation be accepted.
1327. Moved by councillor Rumble seconded by councillor Goldcott that W. Joseph Collins' salary be paid to date of acceptance of resignation.
1328. Moved by councillor Goldcott seconded by councillor Rumble that no commission be accepted by anyone in the employ of this Municipality and that parties entitled to allow commission on collection of Revenue and Road Tax deal with the Council direct.
1329. Moved by councillor W. Gregor seconded by councillor Stride that the Council purchase pump for East Burnaby Well & that matter be referred to a committee of councillor Rumble Goldcott and the Reeve.
1330. W. J. Clark reported that on a test being made of the capacity of the well it yielded at the rate of 1890 gallons per hour in 30 minutes and ^{secondarily} 1440 gallons per hour in 30 minutes.
1331. Moved by councillor Stride seconded by councillor W. Gregor that the Council hire at Royal Oak and that councillors Stride Hill and Rumble be a committee to interview W. Johnston with regard to free grant of land for the site of water works plant.

1342. Resolved that fresh tenders be called for grading Pole Line Road from Mr Tomm's house to Barnett Road to be in by the 24th inst.

1343. Resolved that Third Avenue be paved in the bad places cost not to exceed \$100

1344. Councillor Coldicott complained as to the bad condition of Fifth Avenue which needed ditching. Resolved that the matter be laid over to be taken up under the Ditches & Water Courses act.
1345. Councillor Coldicott also reported that the water was running across 6th Avenue. Referred to Councillor Stride and Coldicott to report.
1346. Moved by Councillor Rumlle seconded by Councillor Coldicott that rock be hauled from Douglas Road at the bottom of the hill.
1347. Moved by Councillor W. Gregor seconded by Councillor Stett that the Engineer with the various members of the Council decide on which streets it is necessary to lay sidewalks at the present time and call for tenders for same.
1348. Resolved that the Bunnaby Sidewalk Bylaw shall not apply to clearing boulevards and that same be charged to General Revenue except in such cases as by resolution are charged.
1349. Resolved that applications be called for the position of Assistant Clerk Assistant Engineer and two assistants for the Assessor and Collectors Office applications to be made to the heads

 in regard to 2 acres conveyed to the School
 Board and assessed in error
 Resolved that W. C. J. Holmes ^{an amount}
 be refunded the sum of \$4⁰⁰/₁₀₀ net of taxes
 paid on these two acres
