Referred to the Clerk to reply that the Council were taking steps to provide the Municipality with conveniences.

as far as possible & that as far they were aware North Burnaldy was not going to be overlooked. & enclose list of roads in North Burnaldy upon which sidewalks were to be laid.

Group one (1) New Westminster District
the same being assessed together with
the buildings and improvements
thereon at the total sum of Two thousand
seven hundred and fifty Dollars (\$2750)
according to the last revised and
corrected Assessment Roll of the
Municipality.
