4 The committee appointed to wait upon the B.C.G.R. with  
5 regard to the change of route of the proposed team line extension  
6 reported that Mr. Spurling had no authority to alter the proposed  
7 route without the sanction of the Board of Trade in London, that  
8 where business warranted any extensions the company would make  
9 them, that the work on the extensions would be commenced in one  
10 month and completed within twelve months, and that a schedule of  
11 reduced fares was being arranged.

13 Moved by Mr. McKee, seconded by Mr. Collicott "That the Engineers  
14 be instructed to prepare data as to the approximate cost of a high level  
15 bridge on the North Road for team and other traffic, and that  
16 a Committee be appointed to interview the Government and other  
17 interested parties as to what proportion of the cost they would assume".

 5 Road through lot 125.

 9 for local improvements in lot 186 be referred to the Special Committee  
 10 Carried unanimously.

12 Moved by Mr. Stude, seconded by Mr. Goldicott "That the offer of  
 13 Th Edwards Development Co. to pay for the additional cost of a  
 14 eight foot sidewalk on Edwards road side of their property be accepted,  
 15 the present sidewalk to be laid on Salisbury Avenue

Carried unanimously.

18 The Enquiry reported on Plans as follows:-

1. Lots 7 & 9 Block 1 D.L. 158.

Recommended that the subdivision be approved.

2. Northly portion of Block 5. D.L. 35.

The whole of Block 5 will require to be subdivided at the  
 one time in order to provide for the subdivision of the  
 southerly portion of this Block. I would therefore  
 recommend that the respective owners arrange for a  
 joint subdivision as indicated in blue on the plan.

3. Blocks 66, 67 & 68. D.L. 30.

It is not easy subdividing this property and adhering  
 to the local plan requirements without a knowledge of  
 how the adjacent blocks will be subdivided. In lots  
 such as these provision should be made for a lane on  
 the westerly side of lot 66 and a half road allowance is  
 required on the South of Block 66. I would like a small  
 committee appointed to look into this subdivision.

4. Whole of D.L. 207, 208.

As these plans were only submitted on Saturday noon,  
 I should like further time to look more carefully into  
 them. Meantime it will be necessary for the surveyor  
 to indicate roughly on the plans the physical features  
 of the country. It is likely that roads running  
 east and west will allow of better grades than those  
 running north and south as shown in plans.
