1 Water Committee. Your Committee met on the 20th November and recommended:

1. That the contract for pumps be let to the Canadian Sawbark Co for \$5785.
2. That the contract for supplies be let to The Robertson Godson Co.
3. That an express ceragon be obtained.

Moved by Cn. Coldicott, seconded by Cn. Stride " That the report of the Water Committee be adopted.

2 Finance Committee. Your Committee met on the 20th November and recommended:

1. That cheques for \$564.11 be signed.

3 Moved by Cn. McDonald, seconded by Cn. Stride " That the Punjab Blasting Regulation By-law do now have a Third Reading.

4 Moved by Cn. Coldicott, seconded by Cn. McDonald " That the Punjab Blasting Regulation By-law, 1911 do now pass its Third Reading, be signed by the Reeve and a Clerk, and have the Corporate Seal affixed thereto.

5 Moved by Cn. McDonald, seconded by Cn. Stride " That the Clerk instruct the Engineer to proceed to D.H. 186 at once, and have a "closed Road" notice put up on all unpassable roads, and do what is possible to repair places which can be done.

6 Moved by Cn. Coldicott, seconded by Cn. Reuben " That the Clerk be empowered to have three separate telephones fixed in the new hall, and an extension to the Police quarters in the old hall.

Carried unanimously

Moved by Mr. Coldicott, seconded by Mr. Stride that Mr. McKeon be the representative of the Council on the Joint Harbour Improvement Committee
