 11 27<sup>th</sup> at 8 p.m.

12 38 applications for the position of Accountant  
 13 were received from which the names of Mess<sup>rs</sup>  
 14 Bucklin Taylor Ballin Griffiths Fisher & Moore  
 15 were selected for an interview.

16 Resolved that the Council lend to Albert Edwin  
 17 Taylor of Central Park Burnaby the sum of  
 18 seven hundred Dollars (\$700) from the Sinking  
 19 Fund for a period of five years the repayment  
 20 of which sum together with interest thereon at the  
 21 rate of six per centum per annum being secured  
 22 by a first mortgage on real property held and  
 23 used for farming purposes by the said Albert  
 24 Edwin Taylor and described as Block twenty four  
 25 (24) District Lot Thirty five (35) Group One (1) New  
 26 Westminster District the same being assessed  
 27 together with the buildings and improvements at  
 28 the total sum of Two thousand seven hundred and  
 29 fifty Dollars (\$2750) according to the last  
 30 revised and corrected assessment Roll of the  
 31 Municipality.
