

Monday 25th September 1911

The ^{advised} Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday the 25th September, 1911

Present. Mr Goldcott, Macdonald, McGregor, McKee, Rumble and Stride, with His Worship the Reeve in the Chair.

Moved by the Reeve, seconded by Mr McGregor "That the Chairman of the Grounds committee be instructed to obtain a landscape gardener to lay out the grounds in proper shape ready for work next spring, and the Engineer work to said plan.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by the Reeve, seconded by Mr Rumble "That the Collector prepare a schedule at the proper time, of lands liable to be sold on account of delinquent taxes, and on receipt of such, necessary steps be taken to have a sale thereon.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr Goldcott, seconded by Mr Rumble "That the Solicitor be instructed to draw up a clause for submission to the Union of B.C. Municipalities at their next meeting, asking for legislation to prevent the registration of plans of subdivisions where such subdivisions will do not conform with the Municipal by-laws governing such subdivisions, in order to avoid the making of signs in municipal roads, etc.

Carried unanimously.

Mr Russell was interviewed regarding the B.C. & R. franchise and Mr Goldcott, Mr McGregor and His Worship the Reeve were appointed a Committee to meet Mr Spurling with reference to changing the route of the one mile of track proposed.
