

1 Monday - August 4th, 1911
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3 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on
 4 Monday, August 4th, inst. at 9 O'clock p.m.

5 Present: - His Worship Reeve Weast

6 Councillors Colquitt, Rumble, Stride, Mc Kee and Mac Donald.

7 Moved by Cr. Colquitt - Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the Minutes of
 8 the previous meeting be adopted as typewritten subject to the following
 9 amendment, viz. "the words "twenty four months notice" to be substituted
 10 for the words "six months notice". 14/11. Carried unanimously.

11 Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

12 Somervell Putnam - enclosing price from D. J. Mac Phalen for
 13 substituting stone steps for reinforced concrete steps at the new
 14 Municipal Hall - \$600.

15 Moved by Cr. Rumble - Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald: - "That the
 16 question of stone steps be not entertained, but that the original
 17 specification be adhered to." Carried unanimously.

18 Burnaby School Board offering to lease the South corner of East
 19 Burnaby School site at a nominal rental of \$150 per. year, for
 20 the purpose of a Yank Site.

21 Moved by Cr. Rumble - Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald: - "That the
 22 offer be accepted, subject to the approval of the Consulting Engineers,
 23 at a nominal rental." Carried unanimously.

24 Joseph Collins protesting against the assessment of Lot 14, Blks 34-48
 25 D.S. 95, as Wild land, together with the Assessor's Report thereon.

26 Moved by Cr. Colquitt - Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the matter be
 27 referred to the Finance Committee." Carried unanimously.

28 Committee Reports

29 Board of Works. - Your Committee met on Monday, July 31st.
 30 and recommend: -

- 31 1. That the Council waive the request for a 66' road across Blk. 5,
 32 D.L. 91, if the lanes at each end of the property are widened
 33 to 20 feet.
- 34 2. That a temporary wagon road and culvert between Blks. 2 and 3
 35 D.L. 84, be made at an estimated cost of \$50.
- 36 3. That Harris Street be opened up 5 chains at an estimated cost of \$50.
- 37 4. That a temporary wagon road to Lot 3, Blk. 0, D.L. 184 be made
 38 at an estimated cost of \$45.
- 39 5. That a temporary wagon road to Lots 12 and 13, Blk. 22, D.L. 122
 40 be made at an estimated cost of \$40.
- 41 6. That a temporary wagon road to Lots 33 and 38, Blk. 1, D.L. 189, be
 42 made at an estimated cost of \$60.
- 43 7. That a plank sidewalk be laid on Albert Street, at an estimated
 44 cost of \$45.

- 1 8. That the Engineer be authorised to repair Pneumatic, whenever it
 2 is in a dangerous condition, and report the same to the Council
 3 immediately afterwards.
- 4 9. That a temporary wagon road be made to Lot 11, Blk. 29, S. S. 33,
 5 at an estimated cost of \$60.
- 6 10. That Lee's Day Labor force be put on to repair the Pole Line
 7 Road, from the B.C.Ry. Track to Douglas Road.
- 8 11. That the Chairman of the Board of Works be authorised to
 9 purchase a quantity of Rock offered by Mc Stewart, for use on
 10 Boundary Rd.
- 11 12. That the Engineer's Report on Plans be adopted.
- 12 13. That Projects of:- Twentieth St. - 10th Avenue (City) to Mara Rd.
 13 Seventh Avenue - 6th Street to Colquitt Rd.
- 14 Patterson Road - Vancouver Rd. to Moscrop Rd.
 15 and Cambridge Street - Ingleton Avenue to
 16 Queens Avenue, be approved.
- 17 17. That the Plans for Timber Bridges on Johnston Road, be
 18 approved.
- 19 18. That the Contracts for Sidewalks on Sprott Rd. and Ledger Rd
 20 be awarded to F. Supden - 1st. Avenue and 10th. Avenue, to
 21 Robt. Lane, and on Mary Avenue to F. Supden.
- 22 19. That \$500 be appropriated out of Revenue for clearing
 23 ditches and repairing road bed on Wiggins Road.
- 24 20. That the sum of \$1000, appropriated for Parisien Road, out
 25 of the Government grant, be transferred to Douglas Road,
 26 provided the approval of the Govt. Road Superintendent is
 27 obtained.
- 28 Moved by C. Remond - Seconded by Dr. Mc Kee: - "That the Report of
 29 the Board of Works, dated July 30th. inst. be adopted."
- 30 Carried unanimously.

31 Board of Works. August 4th.

- 32 Your Committee met on August 4th. inst. and recommend:-
- 33 1. That permission be granted to the Western Canada Power Company
 34 to use the Pole Line on the South side of the Johnston Road
 35 to carry high voltage wires temporarily, provided such wires
 36 be removed in nine months from the date hereof, that the poles
 37 are in accordance with the Plan produced, that the said poles
 38 be so placed, that the wires shall not be less than 40 feet
 39 from the ground, and approved by the Municipal Wiring Inspector.
- 40 2. That the Engineer's report on Plans be adopted, except in the case
 41 of Blk. St. D. L. 24, in which the Board recommend that a
 42 Road Allowance be required through the centre of the Block.
- 43 3. That permission be granted to H. V. Tucker to sub-let the
 44 Contracts for Douglas Rd. and Parrot Rd. to Station Camps - pre-

1 gangs to be allowed to work ten hours per. day.

2 4. That at the Reeve, together with the Chairman of the Board of Works, and
 3 the Engineer, be a Special Committee to look into the matter of Fire
 4 Sprinklers, with power to purchase.

5 5. That in view of the fact that the cost of the proposed Local Improvement
 6 in D.L. 186 together with the Local Improvements already passed, will
 7 exceed the maximum amount to be borrowed this year; the By Law
 8 be deferred until the early part of 1912.

9 6. That the Contract for work on Twentieth Street be awarded to A. L.
 10 Bots and Co., for Seventh Avenue, to J. M. Clemens, for Cambridge
 11 Street to A. L. Bots and Co., and for Patterson Road to A. L. Bots & Co.

12 ✓ 7. That the Contract for work on Royal Oak Rd. from River Rd. to
 13 B.C.E.Ry. be awarded to W. S. Prescott, for Lariboo Rd. from 10th Ave
 14 City to Armstrong Street be awarded to Beckett & Cameron, for
 15 Cumberland Rd. to C.R. Sherdohl, for Delta Avenue to K. Varegan,
 16 for Rumble Rd. to M. Casew., for Seventh Avenue to W. S. Prescott,
 17 and for Pole Line Rd. to Joe Legue.

18 8. That the Pole plan submitted by the B.C.E.Ry. Co. be approved.
 19 Moved by Cr. Rumble - Seconded by Cr. Mc Kee: - That the Report of the
 20 Board of Works, dated Aug. 4th. inst. be adopted.

21 Carried unanimously.

22 Finance Committee: - Your Committee met on August 4th. inst. and
 23 recommend:-

24 1. That Pay Rolls amounting to \$15415.95, be paid.
 25 2. That Road Contract Accounts, amounting to \$2415.60, be paid.
 26 3. That Sidewalk Contract Accounts, amounting to \$346.00, be paid.
 27 4. That Sunday Board of Works Accounts, amounting to \$3168.29, be paid.
 28 5. That Salaries & Sunday Accounts, amounting to \$14424.39, be paid.
 29 6. That Messrs. Cleveland & Cameron be paid \$2615.38 on account of
 30 General Waterworks System contracts.
 31 7. That Mr. B. G. Walker be paid the fees due to him as Police
 32 Magistrate.

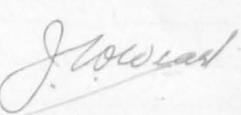
33 8. That the claim of Mr. Ramsay for property alleged to be taken for
 34 widening 4th. Street, be not entertained.

35 9. That the Grant to Burquitlam Agricultural Association, be
 36 increased from \$100 to \$150.

37 Moved by Cr. Colclough - Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald: - That the Report of
 38 the Finance Committee be adopted. Carried unanimously.

39 Police Committee: - Your Committee met on August 4th. inst. and
 40 recommend:-

41 1. That Chief Townsend and Constable Edwards be asked to resign.
 42 and failing this, that one month's notice be given to each man.
 43 2. That the Clerk invite ex-constable Parkinson, and such of the
 44 candidates for the last vacancy, as may be suitable, to meet the

- 1 Police Committee on Monday, August 14th. inst.
 2 Moved by Cr. Colclough - Seconded by Cr. Mc. Kee: - "That the Report
 3 of the Police Committee be adopted." Carried unanimously
 4 Mr Rose addressed the Council with reference to the plan of
 5 Sub division of Lot 5. S. D. L. 91.
 6 Moved by Cr. Colclough - Seconded by Cr. Rumble: - "That the
 7 owner be requested to give an undertaking to the Council, to
 8 indemnify the Corporation of Burnaby against the cost of extropiating
 9 the 55 foot Road Allowance north through the adjoining lot."
 10 Carried unanimously
 11 Messrs. Cleveland and Cameron submitted two proposals for
 12 a Water Supply to Barnet, the one for 4 inch cast iron pipe, at
 13 an estimated cost of \$20,000, the other for 6 inch and 8 inch steel
 14 pipe at an estimated cost of \$15,000.
 15 Moved by Cr. Colclough - Seconded by Cr. Mc. Kee: - "That the
 16 second proposal be adopted, and the mill owners and others
 17 requiring the Water to loan to the Council the money necessary to
 18 instal the service, the amount to be repudged from the
 19 General Waterworks Construction By Law monies."
 20 Carried unanimously.
 21 Moved by Cr. Colclough - Seconded by Cr. Rumble: - "That the
 22 Council make a tour of inspection around the Municipality
 23 on Monday, August 14th. inst. and that the Clerk be instructed
 24 to procure Automobiles for the purpose."
 25 Carried unanimously.
 26 The controller reported that 1500 Debenture Bonds of £100 each
 27 had been received from Wood, Grundy & Co. on account of
 28 By Laws 101 and 101^a, 94 and 94^a, and 98 and 98^a, and that
 29 they had all been signed & sealed.
 30 Moved by Cr. Mc. Kee - Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the
 31 Report be received." Carried unanimously.
 32 The Controller submitted a fully yearly Report and Statement of
 33 the affairs of the Corporation.
 34 Moved by Cr. Rumble - Seconded by Cr. Mc. Kee: - "That the
 35 Report of the Controller be adopted, and that it be printed, &
 36 copies thereof mailed to the ratepayers."
 37 Carried unanimously
 38 Moved by Cr. Colclough - Seconded by Cr. Rumble: - "That the
 39 Council do now adjourn until Monday, August 14th. inst."
